Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter. Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them and, as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, this claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved the issuance of a citation for disorderly conduct, and a criminal investigation under Chapter 979, WIS. STATS.

This claim is being submitted under §895.35(2), WIS. STATS., which provides that:

Notwithstanding sub (1), the City . . . shall reimburse a protective services officer for reasonable attorney fees incurred by the officer in connection with a criminal proceeding arising from the officer's conduct in the performance of official duties, unless, in relation to that conduct, any of the following applies:

- a. The officer is convicted of a crime;
- b. The officer's employment is terminated for cause;
- c. The officer resigned for reasons other than retirement before the attorneys fees are incurred:
- d. The officer is demoted or reduced in rank

e. The officer is suspended without pay for 10 of more working days. *§895.35(2)*, *WIS. STATS*.

Officer's Petkovich, Ciano and Peterson are considered "protective services officer" under the statute. They have incurred the fees compiled in this claim as a direct result of their being investigated for actions taken within their official capacity, and in the performance of their duties, in connection with the use of deadly force. None of the "exceptions" to mandatory payment under §895.35(2) WIS. STATS. apply.

The incident resulted in the District Attorney's Office conducting a criminal investigation into the death of Mr. Glen Kelly, under Chapter 979, WIS. STATS. That investigation qualifies as a "proceeding" which mandates payment under §895.35(2), WIS. STATS.

Deputy District Attorney Johnson reviewed the matter and did not issue charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of Deputy District Attorney Johnson's letter and an itemization of the time and services rendered.
