RE: Permanent Historic Designation for the First National/First Wisconsin National Bank Building 733-743 N. Water Street

At a public hearing held on April 16, 2007, the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) voted to place interim designation on the above property as an historic structure in accordance with the provisions of Section 308-81-10.5 & 8a of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances. Also according to the ordinance, a second public hearing shall be held within 90 days of the interim designation to consider permanent local designation of the building. The original hearing for permanent designation was scheduled for Monday, June 18, 2007. That public hearing was adjourned at the request of the owners. The hearing for permanent historic designation has now been scheduled for Monday, September 10, 2007, in Room 301-A of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street. The meeting will begin at 3:00 PM.

In a separate mailing, you will receive a copy of the final Historic Designation Study Report and the meeting agenda for the September 10, 2007 public hearing indicating when the item is scheduled.
