

It should be noted that Mr. HATCH did recover the \$1,936.60, personal checks, two fanny packs and a wallet containing personal papers from the Milwaukee Police Department. Also upon further inspection by Mr. HATCH he did determine the cases of missing Similac formula he had reported missing were in fact found to be within the afore stated trailer and interior of his vehicle. Therefore Mr. HATCH contends that there is presently \$8,000.00 in U.S. currency reported to be still missing.

As reported by Det. Jeffery HOOVER continued investigation into this matter was met with difficulty due to the apparent uncooperativness of complainant Raymond HATCH. Several phone calls to the residence of Mr. HATCH to further the investigation were not returned. On July 6, 1999 at 1:53pm Det. HOOVER reports that he did receive a phone call from Mr. HATCH. It was at this time that Mr. HATCH related that under advice of council he did not desire to pursue this investigation and did not wish to prosecute any one for the reported missing U.S. currency. Further he instructed Det. HOOVER to no longer contact his residence regarding this incident.

CONCLUSION:

Subsequent interviews of all relevant police personnel and civilian witnesses resulted in no known suspects or developments. Due to complainant HATCH'S request to terminate this investigation and his desire not to prosecute any one in this alleged offense, this investigation will be suspended pending new developments.
