File #001676 is a resolution relative to the acceptance of a Paramedic/Paramedic First Response grant from Milwaukee County.

Background and Discussion

- 1. Under State law, the county is the government entity responsible for providing emergency medical services. The City of Milwaukee provides paramedic services for the City of Milwaukee under a service agreement with the County in the form of a grant.
- 2. The previous grant expired on December 31, 2001. This new contract expires on December 31, 2003.
- 3. This grant from the County will provide \$4,825,228 for the Milwaukee Fire Department's paramedic personnel costs. The grant will fund the 96 paramedic positions in the Department.
- 4. The City will provide \$2,367,739 as an in-kind contribution, making the total grant amount \$7,192,967.
- 5. Milwaukee County pays for supplies, equipment, medical control (physician oversight) and provides training for paramedics outside the grant.

Fiscal Impact

The grant authorizes the expenditure of \$7,192,967 from the City's grant and aid account for the Paramedic/Paramedic First Response Grant.
