#### 1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

This grant will aid the City of Milwaukee Tuberculosis Control Clinic (TBCC) in its screening and treatment activities. TBCC encourages all new refugees to get the free health screening that includes screening for TB, hepatitis, lead, pregnancy, and enteric diseases. Necessary immunizations are also given to children and adults. In 2000, 192 refugees from many countries including Somalia, Bosnia, Vietnam, Croatia and others were screened. The agencies that sponsor the refugees help assure that any health problems found are treated. Any TB issues are handled at TBCC. The rise in TB in foreign-born people is high in the entire US. In 2000, 38% of the TB in the City was in foreign-born people or children living with foreign-born family members. Three active cases of TB were found by refugee screening.

Direct relationship with the goal to control communicable disease in the City, especially TB, and the goal to increase immunization rates. It is also related to the vision of making Milwaukee the healthiest City.
