Assign Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) trained officers in patrols to decrease pedestrian and bicycle crashes, incapacity injuries, and deaths by 5% from last year. Make contacts with local media, community groups, or other groups to increase public awareness of pedestrian and bicycle related crash information, and subsequent enforcement efforts a minimum of once during every quarter.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Public safety through increase public awareness of pedestrian and bicycle related crash information. Educating people on common errors and violations that lead to pedestrian or bicycle motor vehicle crashes, including differences in child and adult errors and crash types. Increasing traffic safety meets the mission and vision of the Milwaukee Police Department.

To maintain or exceed historical activity levels during grant-funded activity.
