
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Mark Lentz, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police motorcycle that was traveling northbound on North 27th Street with its emergency lights activated in an attempt to stop a vehicle for a traffic violation. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling northbound on North 27th Street at a high rate of speed, failed to yield the right away and rear-ended the City motorcycle, ejecting Officer Lentz, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Lentz sustained injuries to his head, neck, arms and right knee. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$12,794.68.

Subsequent to this accident, Officer Lentz passed away from causes unrelated to this matter. As a result, the proposed settlement is with the Estate, who is pursuing the litigation.
