There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered.

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

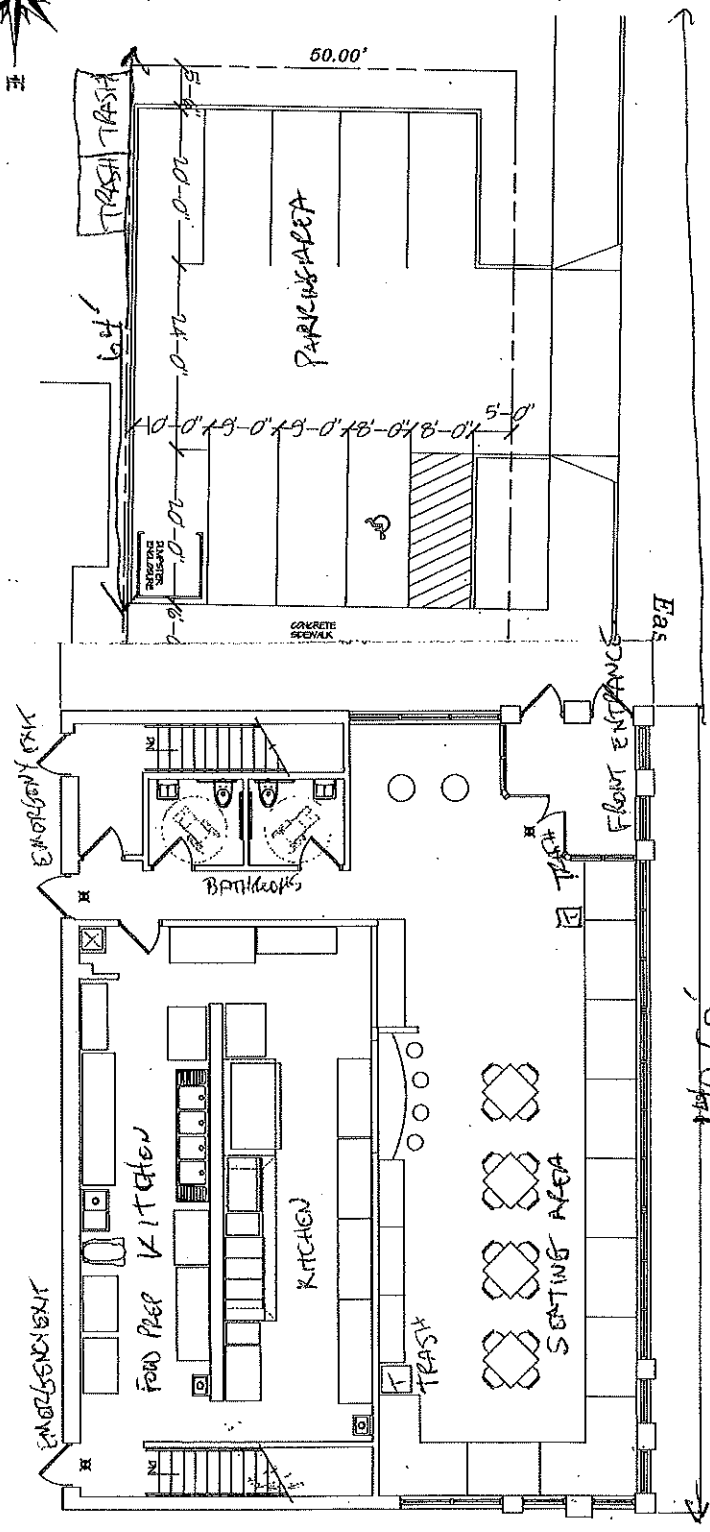

Jaspal SINGH and Balvinder SINGH are co-owners in the business. They currently only have an occupancy license, which they did not have on site. No product is in the business. All the coolers and shelves were empty. They were in the process of installing digital video cameras. They plan on having 6 interior cameras and 2 exterior. Only three cameras were working at the time of the inspection. A solid safety glass partition separates the cashier from the customers. The exterior is well lit, but it is next to a "T" alley that is dark at night and heavily traveled. We made suggestions for safety when taking trash out to the bin that is in the alley. The business currently does not have a drop safe. SINGH stated they were in the process of buying a safe and will have one installed prior to opening. The business has security across the glass windows and door that they will continue to use when the business is closed.



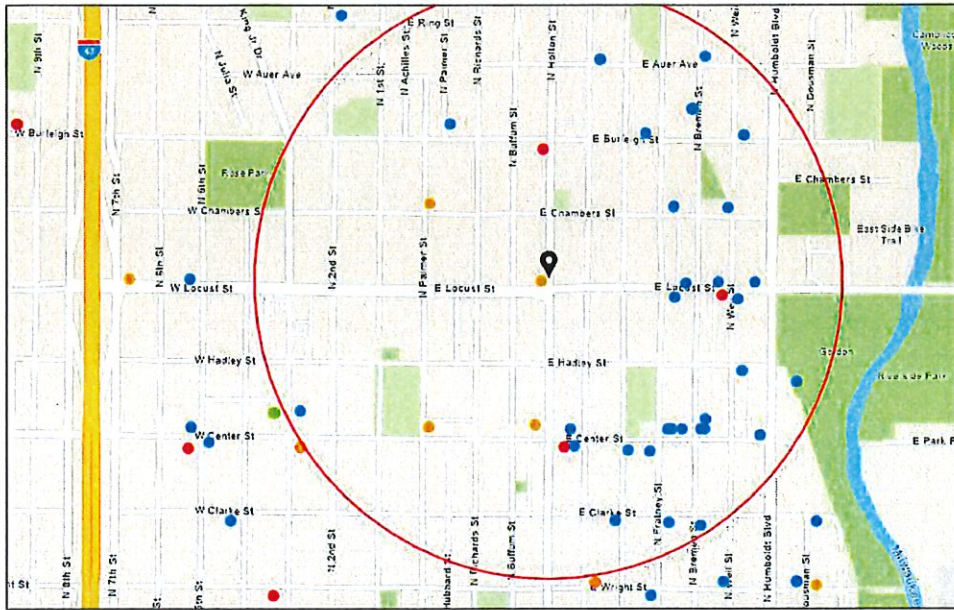
City Concentration Map

Concentration Map

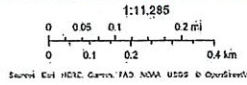

Dear Alderwoman Coggs:

I'm not sure who to write to about this problem, but I chose you. On Thursday, June 6th, a boy was beaten in the head with a baseball bat at the corner of 23rd & Keefe, a few feet from my home. Today, I was told that it was the store owner of Faith Grocery who chased him out of his store and beat him. Today, Black Panthers stood guard outside the store and would not allow the owner to open. I believe it is their intention that the store never reopen. I was worried we might have a riot. I convinced the owner to leave, which he did.

I don't know which facts are true and accurate; the owner claims to have 'everything' on tape, which I very much doubt. He was not arrested, which surprises me. Apparently the boys who were with the boy who was beaten trashed the owner's pick-up truck after this incident. I don't know if the boy is OK.

I do not condone stealing in any form, which is what I'm guessing led to this confrontation. I also do not condone beating a child because of theft, especially not in a lethal way. The store owner could have killed this boy. This is absolutely NOT acceptable, not in my neighborhood. I am the block captain for the 3400 block of N. 23rd Street and I do NOT want this kind of behavior happening in my block ever again.

This report is a basic summary of this incident. For further information please review IR 19-157-0156 and IR 19-157-1057.

On 06-06-19 at or about 7:05 p.m., officers were sent to Faith Groceries, 3451 N. 23rd St., a licensed food store in the City of Milwaukee, for a report of an armed robbery.

Upon arrival, officers conducted an investigation and found that the call was not an armed robbery, but a Disorderly Conduct and Sick and Injured complaint.

While in the store, officers conducted an investigation, both speaking to employees and watching the store video and learned that there were several juveniles in the store, who were grabbing items off of the shelves inside of the store and trying to leave without paying. An employee stepped in front of the juveniles and refused to let them leave the store without paying. Once the employee stepped in front of the juveniles, they circled the employee and began screaming expletives at the employee, as well as shoving the employee. The juveniles attempted to jump on the employee, so another employee ran from behind the counter with a stick and swung the stick in a downward motion, with the attempt to disperse the crowd and keep the other employee safe. It should be noted that officers did watch the video and did not observe the store employee with the stick target a single individual during this encounter. This store has been having issues with groups of individuals who come into the store and take items without paying for the items, then leave the store.

While watching the video from the store surveillance cameras, officers watched one of the subjects that were surrounding the employee leave the group and trip over the crowd, falling towards a large metal cooler door. Once the subject falls to the ground, other individuals begin to push over racks of food items and throw them to the ground, while shouting expletives at the store employees.

After a struggle with the individuals and store employees, the individual who fell leaves the store, by being carried out of the store. After the individuals leave the store, a black Infiniti QX-80 (WI Plate 662-ZRT) which was parked just outside of the main entrance door was damaged by unknown persons. There were pieces of wood and chunks of concrete lying on the sidewalk just outside of the main entrance, next to the Infiniti. The Infiniti had damage to the windows, as well as the hood and passenger front quarter panel.

A check of the LIRA system revealed the business has a valid Food Dealers License (9785-A), which is set to expire on 04-11-20 and the current agent, Harjinder KHASRIA (w/m 09-27-70) was at the business at the time of this occurrence.

On 06-08-19 at 3:46 p.m., a call was placed from the store that the Black Panthers came into the store, but squads were never dispatched. A check of online social media showed on the Black Panthers Facebook Social Media page showed Darryl FARMER (aka King Rick) arrives at the store with several individuals and demanded that the open store close. FARMER demands that everyone leaves the store and that the store employees lock the doors. FARMER was in the store due to the person who had fell in the original altercation. FARMER was stating the person was hit with a stick and having seizures. FARMER did not want the store open and verbally was able to have everyone leave the store and the store employees lock the door, closing for the day.

On 07-18-19, at 12:43 PM, I (P.O. Joseph MERRILL, SQD 5121 with OIT HOLSEN) was dispatched to a Subject with a gun call, at 3451 23rd Street (Faith Grocery), Upon arrival we met with CALLER/VICTIM Ranjit SINGH (W/M 5-12-1984). It was later revealed an Armed Robbery had occurred.

Ranjit stated that one B/M juvenile attempted to pass a counterfeit one hundred dollar bill, which the Clerk (Ranjit SINGH I/M 5/12/1984) refused after testing with a counterfeit test marker. Ranjit stated he recognized one of the subjects who stole from the store 5-7 days prior, and demanded him to leave. A B/M juvenile in black shorts and black t-shirt, backed away from the clerk and towards front door of the business. While backing toward the door he attempted to draw a handgun from his right pocket and handed the firearm to the B/M juvenile in a blue hoodie. The individual in hoodie held the firearm in his left hand while holding the door open for a third subject to grab a box of candy (the same subject who stole 5-7 days ago). Ranjit stated he walked around the counter and approached the subjects in the front door when he observed the handgun. The three subjects fled out the door with approximately twenty five dollars worth of candy. Ranjit stated that while holding the door open the individual in Blue Hoodie waved the handgun around and attempted to start an altercation with Ranjit, asking him to step outside. Ranjit stayed behind the counter until he could not see the subjects on the camera any longer, Ranjit stated that he then approached the door and asked why they were stealing, the two subjects walked back towards the store stating that they would be back for him later.

Ranjit had another employee Gurpeed SINGH (I/M 3-20-1997) play the store's security footage for us where we observed a handgun being passed between a B/M subject wearing black shorts with a blue strip down the side to a B/M wearing a Royal blue colored Hoodie type sweatshirt.

The manager, Bhupinder SINGH (I/M, 01-21-82) responded to the location and assisted with copying the security video, regarding the incident. All members of the business were cooperative during the investigation. Bhupinder stated that since a prior incident at the location, involving "Black Panthers,"

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juveniles have been coming to the store more often making threats to employees and stealing merchandise.

Detective CASTRO, SQD 9268, responded and took over the investigation. The video camera footage was also turned over to Det. CASTRO. SQD 5258 (NAVONE/ALBA-ZARINANA) responded and conducted a canvass.
