Description of work The Boys and Girls Club building, located within Sherman Park and owned by Milwaukee County, is a structure of recent era construction.

> The applicant will be replacing rooftop air conditioning units, exhaust fans and boiler vents at the same rooftop locations they are currently located. The tallest piece of equipment is 73 inches high and the buildig's parapet is 76 inches high. The new equipment is comparable in size to the existing and no existing sidewall penetrations will modified and no additional sidewall penetrations will be added.

All work to be carried out according to the application.


