If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. My name is [redacted] and I am a [redacted] of Square One Holdings LLC which owns the property at 1122 West Greenfield Avenue in Milwaukee. I am writing in an effort to bring attention to the property located at 1110 West Greenfield Avenue in Milwaukee occupied by an establishment that operates as a liquor store.

This establishment contributes to a public nuisance, and greatly so, by selling liquor to customers who consume the liquor in public at or near the premises of this establishment, become intoxicated and a public nuisance. This is an ongoing matter that the City of Milwaukee, the police department and the esteemed Alderman, Mr. José Pérez, are very much aware of. It is my understanding in the past that this establishment had employed security personnel at the property to prevent this very issue from taking place, and for a brief time period in the past I have seen such security personnel, surely employed in an effort to appease the City of Milwaukee. I no longer see security personnel at or near the property, and the issue remains unresolved. Anyone familiar with this issue, needless to say, realizes how such public nuisance leads to depressed property valuations in the area. I have lost one too many good tenants at that property in the past because of issues like this. My current tenant, a tenant that I would like to retain for years to come, has understandably been complaining and frustrated with this ongoing scenario. I respectfully ask those with the authority to intervene in this matter to do so swiftly and firmly and resolve this issue once and for all.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by PO Penny MONREAL assigned to the License Investigation Unit.

On Monday, 02/24/20 at approximately 1:50P.m., PO Xavier BENITEZ and I conducted a license premise check at Greenfield Pantry located at 1110 W. Greenfield Av. Once officers entered the establishment we observed 4 "entertainment machines/charging stations", that were turned on and in operating condition. Officers introduced ourselves to the merchant on scene, who was identified by Wisconsin Driver's License as: Karanpreet SINGH A/M 11/04/01. SINGH was cooperative and provided officers with the following valid licenses for the establishment: Class A; Food; Tobacco; Extended Hours. PO BENITEZ asked if merchants are paying out on the "entertainment machines", however, SINGH denied this. I advised SINGH that although the machines are licensed, they still need a Public Entertainment License for the machines. SINGH stated he would contact the agent via telephone, so I could explain the situation.

I then spoke to Hussein P. GOVANI /m 11/03/57 (owner of the building) and Jeremy HALIN W/M 08/16/79 (owner of machines) via telephone. Both GOVANI and HALIN stated they were not aware they needed an additional license for the machines, however, they would immediately apply for the appropriate license. HALIN stated he had a meeting with the Aldermen on Tuesday, 02/25/20, and he would get clarification on what was needed and how to proceed to fully ensure they were cooperating with City Ordinances regarding the machines.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 9/4/2020 at 12:50 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
