


## TID #77 - HELLERMANN TYTON



- **CREATED IN 2012**
- **FUNDED \$750,000 to assist HellermannTyton to acquire, upgrade and equip their facility located at 67<sup>th</sup> and Good Hope Road and add employment to the City of Milwaukee.**
- **100 new jobs added over a period of four years as part of the monetary obligation.**
