Subject: Resolution to remove a No Vehicular Access Restriction from portions of North 99th Street (east side) between West Lolita Avenue and a point south of West Port Avenue, in the 9th Aldermanic District.

Dear Council Members:

Parcels of land on the east side of North 99th Street between West Lolita Avenue and a point 120 feet more or less south of West Port Avenue are restricted with No Vehicular Access onto North 99th Street. A new subdivision is proposed to be developed generally south of West Bradley Road, east of North Granville Road and North 99th Street. The layout of the lots in the proposed subdivision will require driveway access to North 99th Street.

This resolution will remove the No Vehicular Access Restriction and provide the proposed lots with legal access onto North 99th Street.
