Dear Ms. Williams:

We are in receipt of your claim regarding damages sustained to your property from a broken tree branch that fell on your property at 336 N. 34th Street.

Our investigation with Forestry Section revealed that on June 18, 2025, a crew responded to the subject location and confirmed that a branch from a city tree had broken and caused damage to your porch and fence. The branch was removed. The crew further reported that the tree appeared to be in good health and the branch that failed was alive, and there was no evidence of decay at the point of failure.

On June 18, 2025, General Mitchell International reported the City experienced a severe thunderstorm with 1.25" of rain, peak wind gusts of 17 MPH and sustained speeds of 14 MPH. This wind event generated 58 calls to the Forestry Section for down trees and broken branches. Maintenance records revealed that there were two Forestry related requests for this tree on September 2021 and June of 2022. Both times the tree was inspected and found in good health and referred for sidewalk repairs.

Because these damages were caused through no fault of the City, and the Forestry Section could not have foreseen or prevented this damage from occurring, the City is not liable for damages and your claim is denied.
