File No. 061224 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a US Homeland Security Buffer Zone Protection Grant for the Milwaukee Water Works.

Background and Discussion

- 1. The US Department of Homeland Security (DHS) administers and funds the Infrastructure Protection Program (IPP), which are comprised of five programs that constitute major critical infrastructure sectors.
 - Buffer Zone Protection Program (BZPP)
 - Intercity Bus Security Grant Program (IBSGP)
 - Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP)
 - Trucking Security Program (TSP)
 - Port Security Grant Program (PSGP)

Since its inception, the IPP has awarded over \$1.5 billion to critical infrastructure sectors for protective measures (DHS website). Funds are distributed at the state level.

- 2. The Water Works appears to be eligible for a Buffer Zone Protection Grant award, which it plans to use for security enhancements around the Linnwood Purification Plant as a risk-management project. This new grant operates from 1/1/07 12/31/08.
- 3. File 061224 authorizes the Water Works to apply for, accept and expend up to \$189,000 Buffer Zone Protection Grant Program if awarded.
- 4. No City contribution is required.
- 5. The City Department of Public Works would let the contracts.

Fiscal Impact

This resolution authorizes the MWW to apply for, accept and expend up to \$189,000 US Department of Homeland Security Buffer Zone Protection Grant from the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance for:

- \$120,471 Equipment (complete light poles, video surveillance and accessories)
- \$ 68,529 Operating Expenditures (lighting and video installations)
- \$189,000 TOTAL

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
