They currently receive heat and air conditioning to their space from a large HVAC unit which serves the EI Ray Food Mart. There is a remodeling project happening in the bank area and they have asked to have an independent HVAC unit installed for their space so they can have better control of their temperature. We have proposed to install (1) small Carrier rooftop HVAC unit on the roof above the space, with ductwork distribution down into the bank.
