She is the eldest of nine children, and a mother of three. Currently, Ms. Moua serves as a community member to the Hmong Health Consortium in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She served as board and committee member on many organizations, including the Hmong Wisconsin Chamber of Commerce. Ms. Moua participates in collaboration with other organizations to strengthen output results of services.

Two of her major accomplishments include founding and chairing the Hmong American Women's Association (HAWA), Inc., a not-for-profit organization and Moua Consulting Group (MCG), LLC.

Ms. Moua was recently named Hmong Woman of the Year for 2010 by the Hmong Milwaukee New Year Committee of Milwaukee, WI. She has been featured in the Milwaukee Business Journal, Portraits of Hmong Women Documentary, the Wisconsin Historical Society, and Wisconsin Women's Magazine twice.
