RE: Request to Extend Probationary Period – Damond Maurice Watts

Dear City Service Commissioners:

DPW Operations Division respectfully requests to extend the probationary period for Damon Maurice Watts, who was hired as a City Laborer, December 24, 2023 and is subject to a 9-month probationary period scheduled to end on October 14, 2024 after being administratively extended.

Mr. Watts' overall performance has met job requirements, but he has not obtained the required Commercial Driver's license. We have also outlined in his performance improvement plan the objective of obtaining his Commercial Driver's License Permit and License. DPW Fleet had not been adequately staffed to provide the required 40 hours of entry level driver training (ELDT) classroom instruction within the first six month of employment which is now a Federal requirement. DPW requests his probationary period be extended six months to April 14, 2025. Mr. Watts has been made aware of this request. This is the first extension request.
