Re: July 2025 Updates to the Municipal Identification Card Rules & Regulations

The Municipal Identification Card Rules & Regulations guidebook has been updated to align with changes to the License Division's data retention practices. The changes are reflected in the sections below:

- 1. The creation of Section VIII.C related to the renewal process for Municipal Identification Cards. Renewals are now subject to the same application process as new applications.
- 2. Section IX.B is updated so that the fee for a replacement City ID shall be \$10.
- 3. Section X.B is updated so City ID users must report changes to their name, gender, or address through a new application, and pay a fee pursuant to section IX.
- 4. Section X.C is removed.
- 5. Section XI.B.3 is created so that persons applying for a replacement of a lost, stolen, or damaged City ID must submit a new application and pay a fee pursuant to Section IX.

All these changes are reflected in the Municipal Identification Card Rule & Regulations guidebook, version 1.6.
