Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/15/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1339 South 7th Street (La Cama Club). No violations were observed.
2. On 09/20/2015 Milwaukee police were flagged down regarding a complaint of underage patrons inside the business at South 7th Street and West Greenfield Avenue. Officers conducted a licensed premise check at 1339 South 7th Street (La Cama Club). No underage patrons were discovered and no violations were observed.
3. On 10/04/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at La Cama Club based on an aldermanic complaint of loud music and patrons at the business. During this check, officers noted that the basement storage area was dirty, there were some issues with an electric panel and an exit door was locked. The applicant was advised the exit needs to remain unlocked during business hours and that a referral to the Department of Neighborhood Services would be made regarding the issues in the basement.
4. On 11/01/2015 officers conducted a licensed premises check at La Cama Club, 1339 S. 7th St, regarding a complaint of exotic dancers. Officers did not observe any exotic dancers but did observe an entrance door that was locked during business hours. The applicant had been warned this door could not be locked because it was a fire exit. The applicant stated he locked the door to prevent patrons from entering the side door which he did not have security for.

On Sunday, February 15th, 2015, at approximately 9:58PM, Squad 2470 (P.O. WARD/P.O. MARTINEZ) conducted a License Premise Check of 1339 S 7th St (La Cama Club). Upon arrival, I spoke with the agent/licensee, Gorgonio LOPEZ-SAAVEDRA (W/M 12-02-81), and requested to inspect the licenses. LOPEZ-SAAVEDRA cooperated and provided me with access to view the licenses, which were all current and up to date. LOPEZ-SAAVEDRA stated that he had just recently opened the business after renovating the interior. LOPEZ-SAAVEDRA stated that he is planning on changing the name on the exterior of the building soon. At the time of the check, there were only two patrons within the tavern. The tavern also has an armed security guard staffed at the doorway to screen patrons as they enter the establishment.

During the check, I observed no visible violations and LOPEZ-SAAVEDRA and staff were cooperative with police.

On Saturday, September 20th, 2015, Squad 2311, Sergeant Joel C. PANNING was flagged down by an unknown security company driving a dark blue Ford Crown Victoria and stated that the the bar at S. 7th St. and W. Greenfield Ave., had underage female patrons in the bar.

Within minutes of the complaint we met up with Squad 2311, entered the La Cama Club (7 De Copas) 1339 S. 7th St., and did not observe any underage patrons inside the bar.

During the tavern check, Officers did not observe any violations, the staff was cooperative, and the music was at an acceptable level.

The licensee Gorgonio LOPEZ-SAAVEDRA, M/W, 12-02-81, was on scene and was notified.

This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, assigned to District 2, Early Shift, Community Prosecution Unit.

On August 18, 2015, the Community Prosecution Unit (CPU) received an aldermanic complaint about loud music and patrons associated to La Cama Club.

On October 4, 2015, at approximately 9:36 p.m., Squad 2268 (VELASQUEZ/VODICKA) and 2266 (CORNEJO/ DIENER) and 2264 (ACEVEDO) conducted a license premise investigation. I spoke to Yadira L. Soto De Leon who stated she was bartending. Soto De Leon stated she did not have a bartender's license but the licensee was seated at the bar. I then spoke to Gorgonio Lopez Saavedra who stated he was supervision Soto De Leon because she did not have a license yet. He stated she was still in training and normally doesn't assist his bartenders in obtaining a license until they complete training. I explained to Lopez Saavedra that he or another licensed bartender always needs to be present when Soto De Leon works. He stated he was aware and is always present. I advised Lopez Saavedra of the aldermanic complaints. During a check of the tavern an exit door was found to be locked. Saavedra was advised that the door had to remain unlocked at all times during operating hours or I recommended that he could invest in a fire exit door with a push bar if he was worried about patrons attempting to sneak in through that door. The squads also checked the basement storage area and noted that it was full of empty cans and was dirty. It also appeared that there were some issues with the electric panel. Lopez Saavedra was advised to clean up the storage area and I explained that we were going to make a referral to the Department of Neighborhood Services regarding the conditions we observed.

This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ, assigned to District 2, Early Shift.

On Saturday, October 31, 2015, District 2 Community Prosecution Unit received an aldermanic complaint regarding exotic dancers performing at La Cama Club.

On Sunday, November 1, 2015, at approximately 12:30 a.m., Squad 2411 (Sgt. SCHLEI), Squad 2212 (Sgt. TABIADON), Squad 2266 (P.O. DIENER/ P.O. VELASQUEZ), Squad 2472 (P.O. JUSTUS/ P.O. TOMS), and Squad 2480 (P.O. KOOPMEINERS) conducted a license premise investigation. Officers did not observe any exotic dancers. During the investigation I observed an entrance door to be locked during business hours. It should be noted that on October 4, 2015 the licensee, Gorgonio LOPEZ SAAVEDRA had already been advised that the door needed to remain unlocked during business hours because it was an emergency exit in case of fire. I stated that if he wanted the door to be locked on the exterior he could do that by purchasing and emergency push bar door. LOPEZ SAAVEDRA stated that the door was locked because they wanted patrons to only enter through the front entrance door and not sneak in through the side entrance door because they did not have a security guard working that entrance.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Eliel CONTRERAS assigned to District 2, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, 12-27-15, at approximately 2:10am Squad 2464 (PO Salvador HERNANDEZ and I) was dispatched to 1339 S 7th St (La Cama Club) for underage patrons inside a license premise complaint. Upon arriving on scene, I requested for more squads to my location due to the amount of patrons inside the license premise.

The following squads responded to our location and assisted with the investigation.

Squad 2351 (PO Erik ANDRADE and PO Jason STACHOWIAK)

Squad 2390 (PO James JEKANOSKI)

Squad 2331 (PO Mark BELL and PO Richard MENZEL)

Squad 2412 (Sgt. Joel PANNING)

Squad 2310 (Sgt. Scott THORNE)

While on scene, we instructed patrons to produce their identification cards showing they were of legal age to enter the license premise. During our investigation, it was determined many of the patrons inside the license premise did not have identification on their persons. Approximately 15 individuals had no identification on their persons.

Out of the 15 individuals who did not have identifications on them, five individuals were under the age of 21 and should have not been in the license premise. The five individuals who were underage were not present with their parents or legal guardians on the license premise.

While conducting the license premise check, the licensee, Gorgonio LOPEZ SAAVEDRA (W/M 12-2-81), was very uncooperative and was obstructing our investigation by telling his patrons to not follow the lawful orders of the police and instructing them to leave the license premise. LOPEZ SAAVEDRA was also instructing his bartenders on scene not to give their personal information to police.

While speaking with LOPEZ SAAVEDRA, I observed that LOPEZ SAAVEDRA was intoxicated and had a strong odor of alcoholic beverages emanating from his breath and person. Since LOPEZ SAAVEDRA continued to be disruptive and uncooperative, LOPEZ SAAVEDRA was detained and removed from his establishment to avoid any more disruptions from him or the patrons inside the establishment.

While on scene, I spoke with the security guard, Amicael ZAPATA (W/M 03-16-96), regarding our investigation. I asked ZAPATA, who works for Wisconsin Public Safety, why he was allowing individuals to enter the license premise without proper identification. ZAPATA stated every individual prior to entering the license premise was asked for identification and each individual did provide identification showing they were of legal age to enter the license premise.

I informed ZAPATA as a security guard he must properly check all identifications cards of individuals to make sure they are of legal age. I also informed ZAPATA if the individual's identifications cards are questionable or they look to young to enter the license premise, he has the right to refuse entry.

While conducting the license premise check I did not observe any visible violations. After completing the license premise check, LOPEZ SAAVEDRA was released and allowed to enter his establishment. I informed LOPEZ SAAVEDRA he would be receiving citations for the violations observed on his license premise.

The five individuals, who were underage, were conveyed to District 2. Upon arriving at District 2, the five individuals were cited and released. Prior to being released I asked the individuals how they entered the license premise check. Out of the five individuals, four stated the security guard allowed them to enter without asking for their identifications showing they were of legal age.

The fifth individual, Yesenia NARES-PALMA (W/F 8-10-97), stated she was able to enter the license premise because LOPEZ SAAVEDRA was her boyfriend. I told NARES-PALMA she was only allowed to enter a license premise with her parents or legal guardians.

On Friday, 2-27-15, at approximately 2:20am Squad 2470 (PO Francisco CARTAGENA and I) responded to Squad 2341's (PO Christopher GREER and PO Erik ANDRADE) Shots Fired Complaint at 201 W Mitchell St. While on scene, I spoke with the bartender, Demitris LEWIS (B/M 8-22-85) regarding the incident (IR# 150580005) and conducted a license premise check. While on scene I did not observe any visible violations and LEWIS was cooperative with the investigation. I asked LEWIS why he didn't called the police regarding the shots fired and LEWIS stated he had an incident were two male subjects were involved in a verbal altercation inside the establishment. To avoid any further problems, LEWIS stated security escorted one of the subjects out of the establishment. After escorting the subject out, LEWIS was not aware of the shots fired until he was notified by security guard, Brian L DAVIS (B/M 5-6-83), who by that time called police.

According to DAVIS, two subjects were involved in a verbal altercation inside of the tavern. DAVIS stated one of the subjects was instructed to leave and became very agitated. DAVIS stated once outside, the subject described as a Hispanic male, mid twenties, medium build, and unknown clothing, walked to his vehicle. DAVIS described the vehicle as a red BMW 4-door, with black rims, and an unknown Illinois plate. DAVIS stated the vehicle was parked in front of 200 W. Mitchell St. DAVIS stated that once the subject entered the vehicle, he conducted a U-turn and parked facing west on W. Mitchell St., directly across the street from Bamboo.

DAVIS stated the subject then exited the driver's seat armed with a small black revolver. DAVIS stated the subject then shouted, "Where the fuck is dude at?" On Wednesday, April 22, 2015, at approximately 3:20am, my partner, P.O. Marco LOPEZ and I, squad 2350, were dispatched to a battery cutting that occurred at Club Bamboo, 201 W. Mitchell St.

I spoke with the victim (identified as BRUNETTE, April M, w/f, 04-02-88), who was at Froedtert Hospital, (ER room 34). BRUNETTE stated that she arrived at Club Bamboo on 04-22-15 at approximately 12:00am. BRUNETTE then stated around bar time, approximately 1:40am, she noticed the bar security escort some unknown black females out of the club. BRUNETTE stated the club security then started making everyone leave the club, but since she was in the V.I.P. section she was the last to leave.

BRUNETTE stated at approximately 1:45am she exited the club at the front door and she observed a group of unknown females fighting in the middle of the street in the 1700blk S. 2nd St. BRUNETTE stated as she was crossing the street to walk to her car when a unknown b/f approached her and punched her to the left side of her face. BRUNETTE stated she was able to walk away and she then observed her right hand to be cut open with lots of blood. BRUNETTE stated she was then told her left cheek was also cut open and bleeding. BRUNETTE stated she then got into her vehicle and she went to the hospital.

I spoke with the licensee of the establishment on 04-23-15 at approximately 12:45am, Francisco SANDINO-BADILLO (W/M 03-16-85), and asked him if he was aware of a fight outside the business. SANDINO-BADILLO stated he was at the club on 04-22-15, and a fight between some unknown Black females and Hispanic males occurred in the 100 block of W. Mitchell St, after bar close (approximately 1:45am, on 04-22-15). SANDINO-BADILLO stated his security staff pepper sprayed all the subjects fighting, due to one of the security staff members observed a knife being displayed by an unknown subject. SANDINO-BADILLO stated after his staff sprayed pepper spray the subjects, he observed an unknown w/f (identified as April M. BRUNETTE, w/f, 04-02-89) with a lot of blood coming from lacerations to her arms and face, as the crowd dispersed. SANDINO-BADILLO stated he offered BRUNETTE medical attention with the taverns first aid kit, but BRUNETTE fled the scene in a unknown vehicle. SANDINO-BADILLO stated that all subjects fled the location in unknown directions and the tavern closed for the night. This report was written by P.O. Rómán MARTINEZ, assigned to District Two/Late Power Shift.

On Wednesday, April 22, 2015, at approximately 8:02PM, Squad 2470 (P.O. CONTRERAS and I) conducted follow up regarding an Aggravated Assault/Stabbing investigation at 201 W Mitchell St (Bamboo Club) that occurred on 4/22/15 between 1:30AM and 2:00AM. The follow up was to view and possibly retrieve video footage of this incident.

Upon our arrival, I spoke with the licensee of the establishment, Francisco SANDINO-BADILLO (W/M 03-16-85), and asked him if he was aware of a fight outside the business. I informed SANDINO-BADILLO that a W/F victim left his business and had been cut in the face and hand during a fight near the SE corner of W. Mitchell St/S. 2nd St around bar closing time. SANDINO-BADILLO stated that he was at his business earlier that night but left prior to bar close. SANDINO-BADILLO stated that he did not know of any fights occurring after he left his business.

SANDINO-BADILLO then called one of his security guards that was working that night and asked if they recalled a fight around bar close. SANDINO-BADILLO stated that his security guard did observe a "scuffle" between two subjects across the street from the tavern but no large fight. SANDINO-BADILLO stated that his security guard told him that when they started to head over to break the fight up, the subjects took off from the location and possibly ran into a nearby house.

SANDINO-BADILLO stated that his security guard would be working on Friday, April 24th, 2015 at his other business, Club Mangos (721 S Ceasar E Chavez) if officers needed to speak with him.

Officers then viewed the video from the business, which did not capture any of the events pertaining to the incident and had no evidentiary value.

Later, I spoke with the primary investigating unit, Squad 2350 (P.O. BLAHA/P.O. LOPEZ), and informed them of my findings. P.O. BLAHA and P.O. LOPEZ conducted additional follow up at the tavern and spoke with the owner, SANDINO-BADILLO, again regarding the incident.

During their contact with SANDINO-BADILLO, P.O. BLAHA and P.O. LOPEZ were provided with a different statement from SANDINO-BADILLO. SANDINO-BADILLO indicated to P.O. BLAHA and P.O. LOPEZ that he was present and witnessed the incident, contrary to what was provided to me (P.O. MARTINEZ) earlier. P.O. BLAHA will file a PA-33 License Premise Report regarding the follow up they conducted and the conflicting information provided from SANDINO-BADILLO.

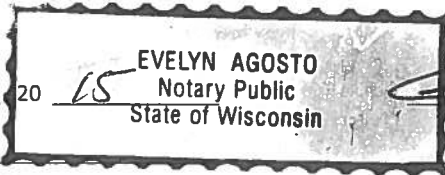

The CPU conducted a license premise investigation at this location on Saturday night and spoke to the licensee of the bar. He was advised of the aldermanic complaint associated to his tavern.

At this time the tavern is not nuisance eligible but if one more incident occurs that is violent, drug/ prostitution related, gambling occurs before 08/22/16 it will be issued a Notice of Nuisance Premises Letter. A PA-33 will be filed that will be available for the license renewal hearing regarding our check on Saturday.

I encourage you to call the non-emergency number 933-4444 or 911 when you observe any of the activities you listed below and give the name of the tavern and the address (1500 W. Scott St.) because it makes it easier for us to track the nuisance activity. Also it is very important that you and your neighbors attend the license renewal hearing and give your objections in front of the license committee because objections by the neighbors in the area are weighted more heavily than police reports. The alderman's office can notify you with a postcard of the upcoming hearing. It will be before February 2016 because that is when their license expires.

I do also want to make you aware that you are not the first person to complain to the alderman's office and since the previous complaint in August the Milwaukee Police Department has conducted 7 business checks at the tavern and also conducts traffic stops and subject stops of people loitering in front of the tavern.


In the past we have called police, but there is no action on their part either. Sometimes a squad is not even sent. We just stopped calling police.

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Police Department has found your business, The Tool Box, located at 1500 W Scott St, Milwaukee, WI 53204 in violation of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances § 90-18-1-a-2 (Presence of Minor at Licensed Premises) on Sunday, November 15, 2015. As an individual or entity that is licensed or subject to a license in the operation of a business upon the premises, you are a responsible party for licensed-related violations that occur at your business.

The sale or offering of sale of alcohol to underage persons or persons not permitted by your alcohol license is a serious offense that may have an adverse impact on the maintenance or future issuance of your license.

In lieu of having a citation(s) issued for the above violation(s), you are eligible to enroll in a municipal citation diversion program called “Respect 21.” If you successfully complete Respect 21, your citation(s) will not be issued. The Mystery Shopper will attempt to enter your establishment and purchase or be served an alcoholic beverage.

IN SOME JOBS, SUCCESS IS MEASURED BY WHAT DOESN'T HAPPEN.

- Enroll in the program by submitting the attached form within two weeks of the date of this letter. There is a \$250 enrollment fee, which is less than the forfeiture amount of the citation(s);
- Successfully pass all four Mystery Shopper inspections; AND
- Not violate any provision of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ch. 85 (general licensing requirements), ch. 90 (liquor laws), or ch. 108 (public entertainment premises) for six months as of the date of this notice.

If you do not timely enroll in or successfully complete Respect 21, the underlying citation(s) will be issued.

In addition, the Milwaukee Police Department may issue a Licensed Premises Report for the underlying violation(s). However, if you successfully complete the Respect 21 program, a subsequent Licensed Premises Report will be issued to acknowledge that your business has enrolled in and completed this abatement program. This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/15/2014 at 1:41am officers responded to The Toolbox Tavern at 1500 W. Scott St to investigate a subject with weapon complaint. The investigation revealed that at about 1:00am three subjects came into the tavern and started to play pool. They appeared to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol and were asked to leave by David TORRES (Authorized Rep of the business). An argument and fight occurred outside with one of the patrons and the three suspects. TORRES had everyone but the three suspects return inside and locked the door. The suspects returned with a bat and broke out the windows of vehicles parked in front of the bar. One suspect was identified as Jose ALVARADO. He was arrested for Damage to Property inc# 14-074-0012. The applicant was on scene and stated this incident occurred outside. She did not have any cameras on the premise.

2. On 11/23/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (Tool Box). Officers spoke to the bartender, Jennifer Rosiak, who stated she was unaware of any trouble. Officers made several attempts but, were unable to contact the caller.
3. On 12/19/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1500 West Scott Street. No violations were observed.

4. On 01/15/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1500 West Scott Street. No violations were observed.
5. On 04/02/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a fight/battery complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox). The bartender, Jennifer Rosiak, told officers a patron of the bar had thrown a bottle at her when she refused to continue serving him. The assailant, along with 2 additional patrons, was removed from the bar and had fled the scene prior to the arrival of officers.
6. On 04/09/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Tool Box). The bartender, Robert Fielbelkorn, told officers that a male and female had been arguing inside the business. Later, while watching the live feed of the surveillance camera, Fielbelkorn observed the male strike the female several times while they were both outside the building. The male then forced the female into a vehicle, which then fled the scene. Fielbelkorn then called police. The vehicle and both parties were located a short time later and the male was arrested. The officer observed no violations inside the business. Milwaukee police incident report #150990020 filed.
7. On 06/25/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a trouble with a subject complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox Tavern). The bartender told officers a customer had become disorderly, yelling obscenities and engaging in verbal confrontations with other customers, and was escorted out by other customers. The disorderly subject remained outside kicking the locked door and pounding on the window. After several minutes, the subject gave up and walked away. This subject was not located by officers, who observed no violations while inside the business.
8. On 07/05/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 1500 West Scott Street (The Toolbox). Officers determined the fight had dispersed prior to their arrival and no violations were observed inside the business.

Velazquez then gets into his car and attempts to run over the patrons he had argued with, one of which produced a gun and fired in the direction of the car Velazquez was driving. Several additional squads responded as well to the fight (Squad 2290, Squad 2213, and Squad 2214).

Squad 2470 (P.O. CONTRERAS and I) responded to assist with the tavern investigation regarding. Prior to police arrival, the subjects involved in the fight had fled the scene. I then spoke with the bartender, ROSIAK, regarding what occurred. ROSIAK stated that 3 B/M subjects were inside the tavern having a drink when they started to become verbally abusive and using profanity at ROSIAK. ROSIAK told the B/M subjects that if they continued, she was no longer going to serve them and they would have to leave the premises. ROSIAK stated that the small slim B/M became very aggressive and demanded ROSIAK to serve him, which she denied. This report is written by PO Eliel CONTRERAS assigned to District 2, Late Power Shift. On Saturday, 8-22-15, at approximately 1:57pm, Squad 2470 (PO Salvador HERNANDEZ and I) was dispatched to 1500 W Scott St (The Toolbox) for a Shots Fired Complaint. Upon arriving on scene, I proceeded to canvass the area in search of spent casings. While conducting my canvass, I observed a pool of blood on the sidewalk located on the southeast side of the building. The pool of blood was around the corner of the main entrance of The Toolbox.

I proceeded to walk inside The Toolbox and spoke to the security guard, Cory A BOYE (W/M 10-1-84). BOYE stated at approximately 2:00am while closing the bar down, he heard approximately three to four gunshots. Upon hearing the gunshots, BOYE told the patrons who were leaving to stay inside and locked the doors. Upon police arriving, BOYE unlocked the doors to allow entry into the establishment.

While conducting a license premise check, the subject, Brandon D HERVEY (B/M 10-01-91) was located at 1308 S 15th Pl bleeding from his mouth. HERVEY was able to be located because officers were able to locate a trail of blood originating from The Toolbox to where HERVEY was located. HERVEY stated he was involved in a fight outside The Toolbox but doesn't remember with whom.

At approximately 1:58am while still on scene at The Toolbox, an Accident PI Complaint came over the radio at S Cesar E Chavez Dr and W National Ave. During the preliminary investigation, it was confirmed the driver, Gabriel VELAZQUEZ, who caused the accident had been shot once in the torso and once in the leg. VELAZQUEZ died on scene from his injuries. VELAZQUEZ was driving a 1999 silver in color Honda Accord.

During the investigation it was determined that VELAZQUEZ was at The Toolbox with his girlfriend, Shayla L HALE (B/F 10-10-81). While VELAZQUEZ drank inside The Toolbox, HALE waited in their car, a 1999 silver in color Honda Accord. While at The Toolbox, VELAZQUEZ got into an argument with some black males, which could have included HERVEY, because he had left HALE in the car. After getting into the altercation with the black males, VELAZQUEZ gets into his vehicle and attempts to run over the black males he had the altercation with. As he drove toward the black males, one of the black males takes out a gun and fires in the direction of VELAZQUEZ striking him as he drove westbound on the 1500blk of W Scott St.

While conducting the license premise check, I informed David TORRES, who is the husband of the licensee, Debra J TORRES (W/F 1-3-63) a license premise report would be filed. While speaking with TORRES, I observed he was intoxicated and had alcohol odor emanating from his breath and person. TORRES was somewhat cooperative due to being intoxicated. I did not observe any visible violations while on scene.

Bradley SCHLEI), 2266 (P.O. Matthew DIENER), 2464 (P.O. Eliel CONTRERAS and P.O. Oscar EPITIA), 2462 (P.O. Adam RUSCH and P.O. Jason WARWICK), and 2268 (P.O. Guadalupe VELASQUEZ and I) conducted a licensed premises check at "the Tool Box" located at 1500 W Scott St. Upon entrance to the premises officers found approximately 30 patrons, no apparent license violations, and one licensed bartender, Robert C FIEBELKORN (M/W 05/13/55), present.

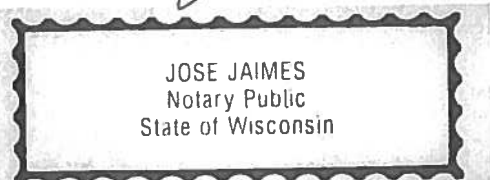



This report is written by Milwaukee Police Officer Claude OSBURN JR, District 2 day shift, Squad 2191.

On Sunday, 10/18/2015, at 11:45am, I was dispatched to 438 S. 2nd Street, for shots fired into an occupied building.

Upon my arrival I did observe some persons standing on West Virginia at South 2nd Street. I did talk to Matthew J. MASON, W/M, 12/02/82, who states that he was inside the bar ZADS (438 S. 2nd Street) at approximately 11:15am when a fight broke out in the bar, while he was in the restroom. MASON states that as he came out he observed several persons involved in an altercation with white female who was bleeding from an unknown side of her face and or neck. MASON states that there was a White Hispanic male that was yelling "that's my girlfriend don't hit my girlfriend". MASON states that he attempted to stop the fight as the owner "Terry" attempted to separate them. MASON states that the Bartender "Josh" took over and Terry went behind the bar. MASON states "Terry" ordered the Hispanic male and his girlfriend out of the bar. MASON states that the Hispanic male became upset because they were put out and the rest of them were allowed to stay. MASON states the Hispanic male struck "Josh" in the face, another struggle begins and the couple was put out. MASON states that the couple entered into a Silver Jeep-like SUV, with a Wisconsin license plate similar to 336-GX_. MASON describes the suspect as white Hispanic male, black curly hair, a mustache, go tee, 30's, 5'06"-5'08", slim build, 190lbs, wearing a white sweater and white slacks. MASON states that the suspect drove West on West Virginia, across South 2nd Street continuing westbound and stopped mid-block and fired six shots from an unknown hand-gun. MASON states that the suspect had his right hand and arm extended in the direction of the Tavern (eastbound) firing those shots. MASON states he was standing outside, fled back inside the bar. MASON states that he does not believe the suspect was shooting at him, he believes he was just shooting at the bar.

While at said establishment I did talk to the bar Owner Terry M. ZADRA, W/M, 04/01/62, who states that he's owned the bar twenty-six years and has never had anything like this happen before. ZADRA states that he was stacking boxes behind the bar when a fight broke-out. ZADRA states that he and his Bartender "Josh" attempted to break-up the fight. "Josh" had told him to get back behind the bar as he "Josh" attempted to put patrons out of the bar. ZADRA states that after a while he did order a white Hispanic male and a woman out of the bar. ZADRA states that after the couple left soon after he heard shots fired and he told everyone to get on the floor, while "Josh" dialed 911. It was later found that one bullet did strike and enter the room, which the owner of said bar, Terry M. ZADRA occupied. This bullet did strike approximately 11 feet above the floor and landed approximately fifteen to twenty feet from ZADRA.

ZADRA describes the suspect as a white Hispanic male, 5'08", medium build, 175-180 pounds, with curly black hair, wearing sunglasses, unknown facial hair, wearing a white sweater and unknown pants possible blue jeans.

This report is being typed by P.O. Jason Schneider assigned to District Two, Day Shift, Squad 2170 with P.O. Ronald Campos.

On Friday, December 24th, 2015 at 8:16 A.M. we were dispatched to investigate a shooting at the address of 438 S. 2nd St (Zad's).

Upon arrival, we entered the open bar and observed a black male sitting on a stool at the rear of the bar. The male was not wearing pants and had what appeared to be a small hole in his right thigh. The bullet hole did have an entrance and exit. The Milwaukee Fire Department did arrive on scene and started to medically treat the victim and then conveyed the victim to Froedtert Hospital for treatment.

During the investigation it was discovered that the owner was on scene and was also the bartender on duty. He was identified as Terry M. Zadra, w/m, 04/01/1962. Mr. Zadra was cooperative during the investigation and did assist with the recovery of surveillance video of the incident. Mr. Zadra was willing to help with any request that we had of him.

Subsequent to the investigation, it was discovered that an argument occurred between the victim and suspect inside the tavern. Both the suspect and victim walked outside of the tavern onto the sidewalk area and that is when the suspect shot the victim in the right thigh.

Squad 2113 Sgt. Craig Sarnow did order me to file this License Premise report.

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On, Friday, January 15, 2016, at 2:00 pm, Captain Heather WURTH, Sergeant Chad RADEN, Officers Guadalupe VELASQUEZ and I, Alderman Jose PEREZ, and Assistant City Attorneys Nick DESIATO and Heather HOUGH met with the licensee of Zad's, Terry M ZADRA, at District Two regarding the MCO 80-10 nuisance designation of the premises due to two firearm related incidents that occurred on 10/18/15 and 12/24/15.

ZADRA was receptive to the meeting and possible courses of action for an abatement plan. ZADRA acknowledged that the problems at the tavern have only occurred recently and were not committed by his "regulars".

Possible items to be included in the abatement plan, if submitted, included up-grading his camera system (already completed), having an additional CEPTED or safety survey completed, encouraging officers to conduct tavern checks during the morning hours, re-training employees regarding not serving intoxicated subjects. ZADRA stated that he understood that the above items were only suggestions and that if he chose to submit an abatement plan it would need to be tailored to his unique problems at his tavern.

To my knowledge, there have been two altercations at Zad's, which resulted in gun shots being fired, and at least one person struck by bullets, within the last 45 days.

As you know, both the private and public sector have invested heavily in this area of Milwaukee, now known as Restaurant Row, bringing an upscale clientele to the neighborhood.

As you are also aware, I have apprised you of several major real estate developers and investors who are actively investing in this area and will increase the tax base significantly, which will also provide new employment opportunities for the District.

In conversations with several District 2 police officers, they have commented upon the shift in clientele and the increase in unsavory characters seen at Zad's.

Investors, Business operators and law-abiding citizens generally do not choose to participate in perceived problematic areas of a City.

I request that someone in authority from the City have a conversation with the owners and managers of Zad's to determine what can be done to eliminate future incidents and to hold them accountable for any future incidents which may occur.

Please keep me informed as to any developments in this regard.

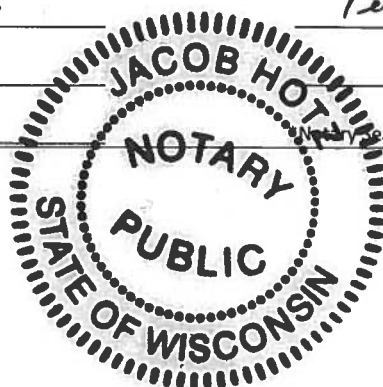

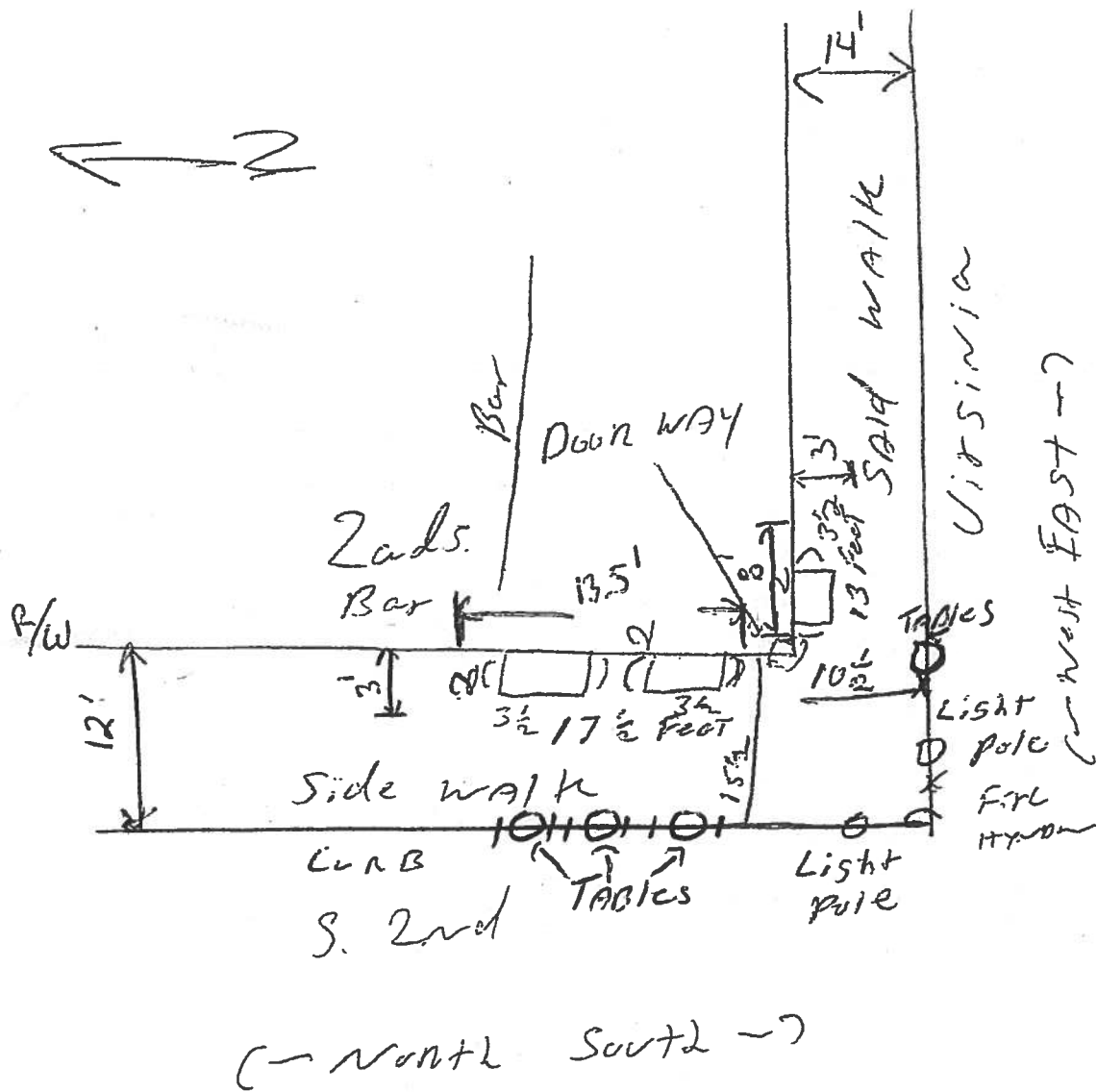
