Shipshape is a joint project of the Milwaukee Public Library and the Wisconsin Marine Historical Society. These funds will provide the necessary resources to convert over 7,000 Great Lakes vessel files from paper format to a computerized database. This will also provide for the preservation of the files. Staff and volunteers have been creating the vessel files for more than 40 years. They are a unique resource used by researchers from all over the world.

The library has created the electronic database and begun to enter the data with the help of the Wisconsin Marine Historical Society. The data is an important part of Milwaukee's marine history. It also applies to the goal to coordinate a grant-writing program to identify, apply for, implement and track grant money to enhance collections, equipment and services.
