

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced of the March 18, 2008 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Ordinance relating to the change in zoning from General Planned Development to a Detailed Planned Development known as Metro Center, Stage 6, for land located at 6865 and 6875 North 107th Street for single-family home construction, in the 5th Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Cammon Council"), do ordain as follows:
Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("Code") a new

section to read as follows: Section 295-907(2)(c):0125.

(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907 of the Code relating to the establishment of planned development districts, the Comman Council opproves the subject Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office

of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the area described and bounded by Parcels 2 and 3 of Certified Survey Map No. 7814, from General Planned Development (GPD) to Detailed Planned Development (DPD).

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(3) The requirements set forth in said

detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area conzoning regulations for the area con-tained in such planned development dis-trict described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such de-tailed plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the detailed plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such detailed plan.

Part 2. Any persons, firm, company Part 2. Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling, or managing any building or premises wherein or whereon there shall be placed or there exists anything in violation of the terms of this ordinance; or who shall build cantrary to the plans or specifications submitted to and approved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or any person, firm, company or corporation person, firm, company or corporation who shall omit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.

Part 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of com-petent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and inde-pendent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining partions. The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irre-spective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.
