- 3. Roll the funds into the 2003 allocation cycle.

CBGA recommends option one for two programs: the NIDC TIN program in the amount of \$667,482 and the City Attorney's Office in the amount of \$64,000 for legal services, June - December 2002.

Options available to the Committee:

Option 1 – (Original File)

2. Request CBGA to solicit proposals for various categories such as Large Impact Developments, Public Service, Economic Development, Housing, etc.
