Dear Mrs. Antunez-Martinez and Mr. Antunez-Jimenez:

You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on Tuesday, October 14, 2025, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider the renewal with a 10 (ten) day suspension of the Food Peddler license located at 4101 W GREENFIELD Av. ("EL PASTORCITO MIXE").

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Licenses Committee, which includes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation, recommending renewal with a 10 (day) suspension of the Food Peddler license based upon the preponderance of the evidence on the Health Department and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for the failure to comply with the approved plan of operations. This recommendation is the result of a public hearing before the Committee held on Tuesday, September 30, 2025.

Please be advised that the Common Council will make a determination based upon the Findings of Fact contained within the Licenses Committee report.

You may file a written response to the report of the Licenses Committee. The written response must be filed with the City Clerk by 4:45 p.m. on Wednesday, October 10, 2025 in Room 205 of City Hall. If you wish to file your objections via e-mail, they must be sent to both <a href="jowcza@milwaukee.gov">jowcza@milwaukee.gov</a> and <a href="stasst5@milwaukee.gov">stasst5@milwaukee.gov</a>. Within 24 hours, you will be sent an e-mail notification that your objections were received. If you do not receive this notification, please contact City Clerk Jim Owczarski at (414) 286-2998. If you file written objections, you or a legal representative may then also appear at the Common Council to make oral arguments supporting the written objections. You will be given approximately five minutes to present the oral argument.
