Exam Components

Human Relations Test – Up to 50 minutes – 25 Questions

- Written multiple-choice test that measures candidates' judgment when dealing with common stressors and situations experienced by law enforcement officers.
- Measures the same critical dimensions as NTN's Comprehensive Law Enforcement Exam.
- Audio option available for all questions.

Reading Test – Up to 20 Minutes – 30 Questions

- Designed to measure the level of written language ability needed for success in law enforcement.
- Fill-in-the-blank style of reading test where candidates must choose the word that best fits in the blank.

Writing – Up to 35 minutes – 20 Questions & 1 Report

- Includes a report writing component and language skills assessment
- The language skills assessment evaluates writing skills that are necessary for common law enforcement tasks such as writing police reports. The skills assessed include English punctuation, grammar, spelling, and sentence structure. Candidates read a sample police report. Some words or phrases will be underlined, and candidates must select the best correction from four standard English options.
- For the report writing assessment candidates will listen to an audio recording between an officer and a witness while taking notes. They will then use their notes to write a report.

PSSA – Up to 10 minutes – 35 questions

- This test measures general attitudes related to integrity.
- Candidates rate their level of agreement with 35 statements using the provided scale.
