WHEREAS, With notable leadership from former league members like President Eugene Manzanet, Vice President and Coach Guerrero Duran and his son Guerrero Duran Jr. as the Treasurer of the board, the league has maintained its competitive and entertaining edge with eight teams battling every year for "La Copa De Don Poncho", named after it founder Francisco Espinoza; and

WHEREAS, Opening Day ceremonies, all-star and championship games have played big roles in generating excitement and enthusiasm for the league, and like all great organizations, it has seen highs and lows, but the community has never given up on the dream to keep a vibrant Hispanic baseball league in Milwaukee, and nothing demonstrates this more than the large crowds of fans that gather each Sunday; now, therefore, be it
