File # 010505 is a resolution approving the *extension* of the contract with Standard Insurance to provide long-term disability insurance from January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2002.

## Background

The City of Milwaukee provides long term disability insurance to selected (police, fire and Local 61 personnel are not covered under this plan) city employees. The current five-year contract with Standard Insurance ends on December 31, 2001.

## **Discussion**

- 1. The City of Milwaukee Department of Employee Relations (DER) Employee Benefits Division will execute an amendment to the agreement to extend a contract with Standard Insurance for a period of one year.
- 2. Long Term Disability Insurance is a Special Purpose Account.
- 3. The premium for years 2000 and 2001 was \$425,000.
- 4. It is the intention of DER to submit new RFPs for long term disability insurance for year 2003.
- 5. The notable **26%** increase (\$110,046) to **\$535,046** for the 2002 premium, from year 2001, is the result of higher-than-anticipated claims in the second, third and fourth years of this contract.

## **Fiscal Impact**

As the premium is calculated by using a multiplier of .36% of *Insured Payroll*, the fiscal impact to the city is \$535,046. This premium amount represents a 20% increase from the 2001 approved budget with an assumption of a 2.5% cost of living allowance increase in the year 2002 salaries of eligible employees.
