
Pursuant to sections 90-12, 85-3 to 85-5, and 108-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Milwaukee and section 125.12 Wis. Stats., you are hereby commanded to appear before the Licenses Committee of the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee at its meeting in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, in the City and County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin at 1:30 PM on Tuesday, June 9, 2025 or virtually at <https://meet.goto.com/498513133> The hearing is being initiated because of the City of Milwaukee's receipt of signed and sworn complaint filed by the Chief of Police seeking revocation of the Class B Tavern and and Public Entertainment Premises Licenses for Ivette Sanitation LLC DBA Punta Cana at 2000 S 13<sup>th</sup> St, Milwaukee. A copy of the above-referenced complaint are attached hereto as well as a Milwaukee Police Department report and copies of sections 90-12, 85-3 to 85-5, and 108-11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Milwaukee and section 125.12 Wis. Stats.

On June 9<sup>th</sup>, you will be given an opportunity to speak on your own behalf, and to respond to and challenge any charges or reasons given by witnesses at the aforementioned hearing in support of a revocation or suspension of your license. You may present your own supporting witnesses, under oath, at this hearing, and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses. If you wish to do so, and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney or interpreter of your own choosing to represent you at this hearing.

If you, Maritza Ivette Pica Fuentes, fail to appear before the Committee as required by the summons, the Committee will proceed to consider the allegations of the complaint which shall be taken as true. If the Committee determines that the allegations are sufficient and the circumstances warrant, the law permits your license be revoked or suspended.
