windows that open toward the sidewalk and street, and can become very loud causing noise to travel extremely far. Upon entering the tavern I spoke to the listed agent Adam F. GRIFFIN (W/M 10-5-1983). I asked griffin if the band was done to the night and he stated that yes they were done. I explained that I was at the tavern for a noise nuisance coming from the next door hotel. GRIFFIN stated that he had no plans to stop having loud bands play with open windows and doors at the front of the tavern facing the street. GRIFFIN stated, "I guess you guys will be spending a lot of time here this summer!" referring to the fact that the police will have to continue to return to the tavern for noise nuisances. GRIFFIN also stated that his tavern had been at the location for 10 years and that the hotel had just opened and that he not changing. P.O. GONZALEZ and I explained to GRIFFIN that passed 50 feet noise emanating from his tavern was a noise nuisance and he could be cited and he stated that that was fine and he'll be seeing us a lot over the summer.



- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.





I found out that in 2014, before my time here, stakeholders in the Neighborhood Improvement District had installed cameras which are connected together. One was installed at the boiler house (1234 N 10th), Silo (1220 N. 11th), and one at 1037 W. McKinley Avenue when it was Cardinal Stritch University. The NID does not monitor these.

The company that installed these cameras was "AA" Security, 262-752-1382, aasecurity@aasecurity.com.

As mentioned in its annual operating plan, the NID does have a static security guard who walks the district Thursday through Monday from 6 PM to 2 AM.

The Neighborhood Improvement District No. 1 maintains several contracts for the District, including landscaping, day portering services, security, snow removal of common areas and maintenance of two pocket parks, Pabst sign and public art. I've attached our 2018 Operating Plan.

MILWAUKEE, WI (February 27, 2018) – Oscar-winning filmmaker and Milwaukee native John Ridley (12 Years a Slave, American Crime) today announced the creation of NO STUDIOS, a hub for the creative arts in downtown Milwaukee. Ridley, along with business partner Chris Abele, has purchased a 40,000 square foot building at 1037 West McKinley Avenue in the newly developed Pabst Brewery Complex. The building is currently undergoing extensive renovations in order to create a social space dedicated to the creation, curation, and presentation of art.

NO STUDIOS is a for-profit venture that aims to become a sustainable model for bringing arts to the city. It will include long-term and short-term office space for local individuals, organizations, and companies in creative fields, a 50-seat screening room, food and beverage services, galleries, as well as a rooftop event space with expansive city views.

The design of the space will be comfortable, open, modern, and inviting, encouraging collaboration among tenants and welcoming diverse communities across the city to celebrate art together.

In addition to serving as a physical space for the creative community and art lovers in Milwaukee, **NO STUDIOS** will present year-round programming that will both provide an opportunity for local artists to present their work as well as bring in renowned artisans and artists working in a variety of creative fields from around the world to share their knowledge and work with Milwaukee audiences.

The name **NO STUDIOS** was hand-picked by Ridley and embodies a double meaning. NO is the Japanese root word for skill, talent, artistic endeavor, while the English word "no" is one that artists hear many times throughout their careers and yet continue to create, in spite of many obstacles.

NO STUDIOS will open in September with a weekend of programs highlighting the many uses of the space, including film screenings and discussions, dance and music performances, readings, as well as photographic and fine art exhibitions.

"I was born and raised in Milwaukee and have family here. I'm proud to be from this city and I'm excited about giving back," said Ridley. "With **NO STUDIOS**, we want to create a place where people can socialize with purpose and go about the hard work that's at the core of creativity, as well as come together and celebrate art. Our goal is to make the space itself, and Milwaukee by extension, a destination for artists, artisans and patrons from across the country, and around the world.

The list of tenants currently on board includes Milwaukee Film, Milwaukee Filmmaker Alliance, 371 Productions, Custom Reality Services, UWM School of Film, and Marquette University. Milwaukee Film will occupy an entire floor in the building and is slated to move in this spring.

NO STUDIOS is partnering with local businesses Abacus Architects, Associated Bank, CSA Commercial, Greenfire Management Services LLC, marketing agency Rev Pop Inc., and communications firm Buzz Monkeys Inc.

John Ridley's critically acclaimed documentary about the Los Angeles uprising LET IT FALL: LOS ANGELES 1982-1992 premiered in theaters and aired on ABC in April 2017. It is currently available on Netflix. Ridley previously won an Oscar® for writing "12 Years a Slave" and was the creator, director, and executive producer of ABC's Emmywinning series "American Crime." 


Ridley IPCO LLC First Floor Furniture Plan as of June 2018

I asked him what type of dispute and he stated it was about him dancing on some female and the guy got angry. BULL stated they started pushing on each other and he then threw a punch to get McARTHUR to leave him alone. I then advised BULL he was being detained, so that I could complete my investigation.

I interviewed Marquis MURFF a doorman at the bar regarding this incident. MURFF stated he witnessed the two guys exchanging words with one another then he saw them pushing each other that is when he started heading in their direction because a fight was about to happen. MURFF stated that before he could get to them he witnessed BULL take the beer bottle he was drinking from and throw it at McARTHUR striking him in the rear of his head. MURFF stated McARTHUR started bleeding from the head so he was asked to leave to avoid blood getting on other patrons, BULL was then put out for throwing the beer bottle.

I then spoke with Taylour J JOHNSON regarding this incident. JOHNSON stated some male in a dark hat and jacket was dancing on her and made her feel uncomfortable so she told him to stop. JOHNSON stated BULL and a female that was with him started laughing at her and McARTHUR while McARTHUR was telling BULL that its not cool to be on his girlfriend like that. JOHNSON stated she and McARTHUR were walking away and the next thing she saw was a bottle striking her boyfriends head and he started bleeding really bad. I questioned JOHNSON about seeing who hit McARTHUR, she stated they were walking away from BULL when it happened but she knows that BULL was drinking a beer while the two were exchanging words.

I then determined that it was a glass bottle that BULL threw and not a punch at McARTHUR. I then advised BULL he was being arrested for his actions inside Trinity's. Sqd 1442 (PO Thomas FRANK/PO Sean KOSCIELAK) conveyed BULL to PPS where he was booked for Substantial Battery.

McARTHUR was transported by Bell Ambulance #412 to Sinai Samaritan Hospital for treatment. McARTHUR was admitted at 1:35am to the hospital and treated by PA Robert DEAN for a laceration to the back of his head. DEAN stated McARTHUR was going to have ties and glue in his head to aide in healing the injuries. Hair Ties he stated is a way lessen medical cost for patients, This method is an alternative way, but is the same as if stitches/staples were used. Sqd 1490 (Christopher PETERSON) responded and took eight photos of McARTHUR.

This case is cleared by arrest and will be reviewed by the DA on Monday at 1:30pm Rm 110.

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This report is written by PO Thomas FRANK, assigned to District 1, Late Power shift. On Thursday, November 23rd, 2017, at 1:43AM, I was flagged down for a fight outside of 125 E. Juneau Ave. (Trinty Three Irish Pub's). Upon my arrival, I observed a subject later identified as, Denzel D. ROBINSON, B/M, 10/4/91, attempting to throw punches while yelling and using profane language. There were multiple individuals attempting to hold ROBINSON back, and separate him from the individual whom he was attempting to fight. ROBINSON continued to physically push past these individuals and throw additional punches. ROBINSON was eventually separated, and taken into custody for his actions.

The other individual that ROBINSON was fighting, was identified as, Christopher D. RICH, B/M, 8/2/89. RICH is an employee of Trinty, and was working as security. RICH stated ROBINSON was being loud and boisterous inside of the tavern, at which time he asked ROBINSON to leave. RICH stated ROBINSON began to get confrontational with him, and began to threaten him. RICH stated he grabbed ROBINSON by the arm and escorted him out of the tavern, at which time ROBINSON took a swing at him, and the two of them began to physically fight in the street.

It was my observation that both subjects had to be physically restrained several times, and that both subjects were extremely aggressive toward each other. Once they were both separated, RICH did immediately calm down, and stand on the sidewalk outside of the tavern. ROBINSON continued to yell, scream, and cause a scene while attempting to continually provoke RICH.

There were approximately 150-200 patrons on the sidewalk and in the middle of the street when this was occurring, and there did not appear to be an adequate number of staff outside in order to control the crowd. Once the individuals were separated and order was restored, Trinty staff was helpful with clearing the street, and getting all of their patrons back onto the sidewalk.

ROBINSON was cited for Disorderly Conduct.

This report is written by PO Thomas FRANK, assigned to District 1, Late Power shift. On Saturday, June 2nd, 2018, at 2:11AM, Sq. 1442 (PO Molly PLUMLEY & I) were flagged down for a trouble with subject complaint inside of the location of 125 E. Juneau Ave. (Trinty's Three Irish Pubs). Upon our arrival, I observed two individuals struggling with each other, one of which was a patron identified as, Evagelia J. KARDARIS, W/F, 2/12/94. The other was an employee, who was working as security and identified as, Austin J. LUDWIG, W/M, 12/2/93. LUDWIG appeared to be restraining KARDARIS, and was attempting to physically remove her from inside of the tavern. KARDARIS was screaming and yelling loud profanities, while flailing her arms wildly and what appeared to be an attempt to fight LUDWIG. PO PLUMLEY and I assisted with removing KARDARIS from inside of the location, at which time she continued to scream and yell, and attempted to pull away from officers several times, in order to re-enter the tavern. KARDARIS was causing a disturbance and a large crowd to gather with her actions, at which time she was arrested. Upon speaking to KARDARIS, she informed officers that the subject inside of the tavern that she was fighting with was actually an ex boyfriend of her's. KARDARIS stated that LUDWIG and herself had just broken up a few days ago, and upon seeing her inside of the tavern, LUDWIG became upset, grabbed her, and attempted to kick her out of the bar. KARDARIS stated she did nothing wrong, and that LUDWIG was using his job as security to take out a personal issue between the two of them.

I then went inside of the tavern to speak with LUDWIG regarding this incident. Upon speaking to LUDWIG he told me that he had no idea who KARDARIS was, and that she attempted to enter an area of the bar which was closed, at which time he had to escort her out. I told LUDWIG that KARDARIS had informed me that they were dating, and that he was not acting under his job duties. I told him that KARDARIS told PO PLUMLEY and I that this was a personal vendetta, and that he needed to tell me the truth. LUDWIG again denied knowing who KARDARIS was, and that he had never seen her in his life. LUDWIG again stated he was just doing his job by escorting a patron out who was trying to access an area that was closed.

Through our investigation it was revealed that LUDWIG was attempting to mislead officers by stating he did not know KARDARIS, in order to prevent getting in trouble at work. LUDWIG did in fact know KARDARIS, and the two of them got into an altercation that had nothing to do with work or the extent of his job duties. KARDARIS was cited for Disorderly Conduct, Citation #J980G8CTND. LUDWIG was cited for Obstructing an Officer, Citation #J980G8CTNF.


