authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of up to \$150,000 in private contributions to the Hartung Park project for purchasing various park amenities.

BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION

- 1. The Hartung Quarry site is located near West Keefe Avenue and North Menomonee River Parkway. For over 40 years, the City of Milwaukee has used the Hartung Quarry site as a depository for clean fill.
- 2. The Hartung Quarry site is approaching its fill capacity. Once filled, a portion of the site will be converted into a recreational facility. The City worked with area residents to develop a plan for the conversion. The conversion plan (File #060292) was approved by the Common Council) on July 12, 2006.
- 3. On April 17, 2007, the Common Council adopted a resolution (File #061445) authorizing and directing the Commissioner of Public Works to apply for a State of Wisconsin Stewardship Local Assistance Grant in the amount of \$250,000 for the purpose of developing Phase I of the Hartung Park recreational facility. The resolution stated that the local share for Phase 1, consisting of City and project partners would be \$379,500.
- 4. On February 26, 2008, the Common Council adopted, a resolution (File # 071402) authorizing the Department of Public Works to fund and construct Phase 1 of the Hartung Park project.
- 5. The total estimated cost of Phase 1 of the Hartung Park project is approximately \$630,000 with \$250,000 provided by a Wisconsin Stewardship Local Assistance Grant, \$250,000 provided by the City, and the balance provided by private contributions. The City's 2008 Capital Budget includes funding for the City's portion of Phase 1 of the Hartung Park project.

FISCAL IMPACT

This resolution authorizes the Department of Public Works to accept and expend up to \$150,000 in private contributions, for the purchase of various Hartung Park amenities such as playground equipment.
