REASON FOR REQUEST:

Kenyatta Riggins, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of her employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was traveling southbound on South Cesar Chavez Drive. After the City vehicle stopped in traffic at the intersection with Greenfield Avenue, the uninsured motorist, who was also traveling southbound on South Cesar Chavez Drive, failed to yield the right away and rear ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Ms. Riggins sustained injuries to her neck and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$11,359.64.
