File #011488 is a substitute resolution authorizing and approving a contract for collection services for overdue municipal court judgments with Professional Placement Services, L.L.C..

Background and Discussion

- 1. Since 1996, Professional Account Management, Inc. (a/k/a Professional Placement Services, L.L.C.) has serviced overdue municipal court judgments on behalf of the City of Milwaukee. The 5-year contract was scheduled to expire December 31, 2001.
- 2. On July 2, 2001, the Common Council passed Resolution 010212, authorizing the City Attorney to request proposals for the contract for the colleciton services of overdue municipal court judgments.
- 3. The City Attorney advertised for RFPs in the Daily Reporter, the Business Journal, and the Milwaukee Journal Sentinel during October and November 2001.
- 4. On December 27, 2001, the Common Council passed Resolution 011095 authorizing a 3-month contract extension to Professional Placement Services through March 31, 2002.
- 5. The City Attorney conducted interviews with RFP respondents on January 31, 2002, later determining that Professional Placement Services, L.L.C. met all requirements.
- 6. This resolution approves a 5-year contract for collection services of overdue municipal court judgment with Professional Placement Services, L.L.C., commencing April 1, 2002.
- 7. Contract terms allow for a retention of 24% of collections, however, the firm remits gross receipts. The City Attorney's office estimate 2002 billable services are \$400,000.
- 8. Payments to Professional Placement Services, L.L.C. and Kohn Law Firm are paid from the Collection Contract special projects accounts, administered by the City Attorney's office. The 2002 budget provides \$1 million funding for the account.

Fiscal Impact

This resolution authorizes the expenditure of \$400,000 from the Collection Contract special projects account for the purpose of contracting collection services of overdue municipal court judgements with Professional Placement Services, L.L.C.
