Gray Preparatory Academy, that provided quality education for scholars from K-4 through 6th grade; and*

Gray also enjoyed spending quality time with her loving family including her husband of 55 years prior to his passing, her nine children, 27 grandchildren and 32 great grandchildren and six great great grandchildren, all of whom will cherish her memory; now, therefore, be it*
