File #001455 is a resolution relative to application and funding of a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Funding Assistance Program grant.

Background and Discussion

1. The Milwaukee Fire Department annually receives funding from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services' Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services Funding Assistance Grant.
2. The grant will provide \$30,000 for the purchase of emergency medical supplies and emergency medical equipment.
3. The total amount of the grant is \$44,721. The City will contribute \$14,721 in the form of an in-kind contribution.
4. In previous years, the grant has been used to fund items such as the defibrillator that is available in City Hall and emergency medical supplies for the EMS Bicycle Response unit.
5. The grant runs from July 1, 2000 to June 30, 2001.

Fiscal Impact

The resolution authorizes the acceptance of and the expenditure of \$44,721 (\$30,000 from the State of Wisconsin and \$14,721 as the City's in-kind contribution) from the Grant and Aid Account for Wisconsin EMS Funding Assistance Program grant.
