File #001455 is a resolution relative to application and funding of a Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Funding Assistance Program grant.

## **Background and Discussion**

- 1. The Milwaukee Fire Department annually receives funding from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services' Wisconsin Emergency Medical Services Funding Assistance Grant.
- 2. The grant will provide \$30,000 for the purchase of emergency medical supplies and emergency medical equipment.
- 3. The total amount of the grant is \$44,721. The City will contribute \$14,721 in the form of an in-kind contribution.
- 4. In previous years, the grant has been used to fund items such as the defibrillator that is available in City Hall and emergency medical supplies for the EMS Bicycle Response unit.
- 5. The grant runs from July 1, 2000 to June 30, 2001.

## Fiscal Impact

The resolution authorizes the acceptance of and the expenditure of \$44,721 (\$30,000 from the State of Wisconsin and \$14,721 as the City's in-kind contribution) from the Grant and Aid Account for Wisconsin EMS Funding Assistance Program grant.
