Dear Mr. Robinson:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$895.00 relating to tow and storage fees for your 1946 IHC truck that was towed on June 29, 2003 from 3400 South 92nd Street.

Our investigation reveals your vehicle was placarded on June 25, 2003 due to a citizen complaint. On June 25, 2003 the Department of Public Works (DPW) sent you a notice stating you had 24 hours to move your vehicle or it would be towed. The notice was sent to your address on record with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT), 1721 Tiffany Drive, Racine, WI. The DPW returned to the location on June 28, 2003 and found the vehicle had not been moved and was in the same location. The vehicle was then processed for towing, which was completed on June 29, 2003. The City of Milwaukee tow lot sent their standard tow letter to you, the listed owner at the address (on Tiffany Drive in Racine) on record with the DOT.

The tow lot records indicate the tow and storage fees for your vehicle as of August 8, 2003 are \$895.00. The charges shall increase by \$20.00 per day until you pick the vehicle up or the tow lot disposes of it. The tow lot has placed a hold on the vehicle and will not dispose of it until

September 1, 2003. Notice was properly given, and as such, the City will not waive the outstanding tow and storage fees. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
