

I can be reached at the address and telephone number below. I would appreciate and expect an expeditious response to this letter and my request. This has been going on far too long and needs resolving immediately.



Dear Ms. Itson:

We have received the claim you and your late husband, Robert filed in the amount of \$17,678.00, relating to personal property losses and clean-up costs associated with your basement; when it flooded on or about December 9, 2003 due to City construction activity near your home.

Pursuant to the October 25, 2006 conversation you had with our office, the City of Milwaukee is prepared to offer you \$2,000.00 to settle this claim. The claim did not contain any documentation regarding the valuation placed on the items you are seeking compensation for. The valuation placed on the items seems to be excessive, thus based on the information we have; the City is willing to settle this claim for \$2,000.00.

Dear Sir/Madame:

On Tuesday, December 9, 2003 the lower level of my home was flooded as a result of the work that was being done by American Sewerage of whom was under contract with the City of Milwaukee. The underground work was being done at the intersection of 21st Street and Roosevelt Drive. My home is located on the southwest corner of 21st and Roosevelt. This incident occurred sometime between 7:00 and 10:00 a.m..

A representative from American Sewerage indicated that they were not negligent and that the city had not marked the water main as it should have been. When excavation of the project commenced, a main pipe was ruptured and hence flooded my finished basement, completely destroying my carpeting, wall paneling, washer, dryer, television and most of the furniture. Please see attached pictures of some of the damage. If you would prefer, the pictures can be sent to you digitally for clarity.

As a result of the City's negligence, my basement was flooded and I am therefore seeking reimbursement for my losses and clean-up costs. I have attached an itemized list in compliance with the Section 893.80 (1).
