Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found west bound motorists on North Wahl Avenue and East Water Tower Road have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling on North Terrace Avenue when vehicles park close to the corner. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing these restrictions to increase cross traffic visibility at the intersections.
