## H) COMPUTATIONS USED IN ARRIVING AT FISCAL ESTIMATE:

Based on past experience, there is no significant impact on Parking Enforcement or Tow Lot to enforce this ordinance. There is an impact on the Tow Lot staff to sell certificates, inspect vehicles, review applications and vehicle titles and check for stolen vehicles, however no additional staffing has been requested to implement this program. During 2004, 610 vehicles were cited, 359 vehicles were towed and 62 certificates were sold. Of the vehicles towed, 20% had no registered owner and 15% had no license plates. Approximately 19% of the vehicles towed were not claimed. It is not known the number of stolen vehicles towed under this program. Any vehicle towed or tow eligible under this program would have been checked as a stolen vehicle and towed accordingly.
