Please be advised that the Elevator Constructors and their Contractors have reached an agreement providing for the following rates of wages and fringe benefits **effective January 1, 2005.**

Employer contributions paid into the various fringe benefit trust funds for Elevator Constructors are as follows, effective January 1, 2005, and paid on all hours worked.
