There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

### Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

#### To whom it may concern:

As a resident / homeowner that lives at 23rd & National, I am writing this in regard to the laundromat located at 2227 West National Ave. My family and I have lived at 2304 West National since September of 1996. Over the years and most recent 2 summers, we have seen many disturbing occurrences at the address of the laundromat. At any hour of the day, cars pull into the parking lot and people from the vehicle get out and loiter in the parking lot. I have seen known drug users and sellers hang out for hours. Prostitutes and their pimps hang out at the laundromat as well. Public urinating on the west side of the building at the dumpster is happening throughout the day. The noise from cars in the parking lot playing their music loudly is also a disturbance throughout the day. Litter from people hanging around the building also spills onto the street and neighboring properties. I have made several calls to the Milwaukee Police many times regarding issues that are bringing down the quality of community at this intersection. It appears that the laundromat has very much become a hangout for drug users, alcoholics, pimps, prostitutes and homeless people.

An increase in monitoring of the business might be a help to keep all of the community safe. If the business remains, perhaps having an attendant on duty at all times would help. Otherwise a security guard could reduce the nuisances.

Dear Licenses committee of the common council.

This letter is to appeal to the objection of the business license for G and G Consulting Company Laundry Facilities for Koala-T Laundry, 2227 W National Ave Milwaukee Wisconsin. We would like to be reconsidered for the business license for the following reasons.

We are writing you concerning the Koala-T Laundromat at 2227 West National in Milwaukee. The problems facing the location concerning crime and the issue of our business license. We are and have been very concerned with the ongoing issues surrounding the location. The business has been a part of the neighborhood over the last 30 years and the past two years we have seen and intense increase in crime in the area.

We want you to know what we have been doing and what we are planning on doing. For the past several months we have been working with Pablo from Operation Impact. They continue to patrol the neighborhood and our Laundromat. Their presence has helped but it has not been enough on its own. We increased our own employees in the location and push to keep out those who are not supposed to be there, our efforts have also not been enough. We are happy the city also has noticed what we are going through and want to work to help with the crime that not only affects us but also our neighbors.

Here is what we are doing to combat these problems. Starting immediately, we have increased our employees throughout the day to help with more cleaning inside and out of the building. They are instructed to call Operation Impact or the police dept. immediately when someone is on the property or in our location that is not doing laundry. Our Landlord is having motion detecting lights installed on the outside of the building to help illuminate anyone trying to hang around or hide around the building in the evening hours. Installing more signs indicating no loitering along with establishing a NO STAND ORDER on the property. This will allow the police to remove anyone standing around our property. We have contacted District 2 to help with this along with doing a survey of the property to give us any other help or suggestions to help us combat the issues. Pablo has agreed to walk the neighborhood with us so we can meet with and discuss with our neighbors the issues we are all having. These problems don't just affect us but them as well in the homes they live in.

We have been in Milwaukee for several years and have our yearly inspections done by Dept. of Neighborhood Services who also used to issue the business license. We were made aware that we needed to apply directly with the city of Milwaukee for the business license now we have since filed all of the documentation to accomplish this. It was brought to our attention on the 24th of June that we did not have our license. We are aware that is our responsibility and we did not intentionally not renew. We immediately applied again after we were told we had to either close the location or apply and pay fines while open. We have so much invested and want to be a successful business in Milwaukee while creating jobs and continuing to meet vital needs of the neighborhood We want to be a positive part of this community and look for your guidance. We would like to please be reconsidered for our business license.



## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


