AGREEMENT BETWEEN

2013-2014 Traffic Mitigation
Zoo Interchange Project

This agreement is a formal partnership, made and entered into between the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DEPARTMENT) and the City of Milwaukee Police Department - Safety Division (CITY), to provide for services as described herein. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation and City of Milwaukee Police Department - Safety Division are partnering during the Zoo Interchange Project (PROJECT) to ensure increased pedestrian safety during roadway reconstruction.

The DEPARTMENT advises implementation of a comprehensive and cost effective transportation management plan that will help ensure the safety, accessibility and mobility for the traveling public in the PROJECT area. The PROJECT area is defined as interstates I-94 and I-894/USH-45 from Lincoln Avenue on the south, west of Underwood Parkway on the west, Burleigh Road on the north and 70th Street on the east. Included in the PROJECT area are local alternate route streets within two miles of the interstate roadways.

To mitigate traffic impacts caused by the PROJECT, the DEPARTMENT will provide \$25,000 to the CITY. In turn, the CITY will provide planning, coordination and staffing services (as outlined below) in an effort to ensure increased pedestrian safety in the PROJECT area and stay informed of PROJECT roadway closures and construction progress for a 2-year period commencing on January 1, 2013 and ending on December 31, 2014.

School Crossing Guard Enhancement

The CITY will provide additional School Crossing Guards at key locations in the PROJECT area. The determination of placement of the School Crossing Guards is based upon:

- Pedestrian volume in school zones
- Traffic volumes at specific intersections
- Requests by citizens, MPD, WisDOT, or neighboring communities.

The DEPARTMENT and the CITY reserve the right to eliminate or add locations depending on the determinants mentioned above.

The estimated contract costs are outlined below:

Crossing Guard Salaries - \$20,000

One crossing guard for 2013 and 2014 at to-be-determined locations.

Equipment/Uniforms - \$5,000

Uniforms and equipment purchased and used by the crossing guards while fulfilling their guard duties only at the locations above.

Total: \$25,000

Basis of Payment

The CITY shall charge actual costs incurred and attributable to the work performed and described above under this agreement to the DEPARTMENT. The DEPARTMENT will provide to the CITY reimbursable funding for these functions in the amount of \$25,000. Total reimbursement to the CITY for traffic mitigation measures under this agreement will not exceed \$25,000. Billings, or a billing, shall be directed by the City to the attention of Chris Hager, Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Southeast Region, 141 NW Barstow Street, P.O. Box 798, Waukesha, WI 53187-0798 and will include a statement of expenses supported by a description of items and services to be provided and expended. The Department shall pay the bill (or billings, as the case may be) promptly upon receipt thereof.


