
Subject: Taxi Complaint

My formal complaint against Yellow Cab driver #442 that took place 10/6/2016:

Cab #442 picked me up from work around 4:27 pm. I have had this driver before but didn't recognize him until I got in the cab. He picked me up previously about a month ago and demanded that I let him scan my card on his personal cell phone. I refused, citing that the company doesn't allow that. He then demanded cash. I told him I just had my card. I asked why I couldn't use the Verifone system and he lied and said it was out of order. He kept demanding cash at that point and became angry that I did not accommodate his wants. He began shouting in the cab and people at the grocery store started to stare. He was loud and belligerent. Demanding to come inside the store with me so I could get cash.

This behavior continued until I called the company while still sitting in his cab. He told me to get out and pay him 5 bucks extra in cash the next time he picked me up.

10/6/2016: Today he asked if I had cash when I got in the cab. I told him I just had my card. He said "this is a problem". When we arrived to my destination he pulled out his phone and just like previously demanded that I let him scan my card on his phone. I refused and he again asked for cash. I told him I don't normally carry cash and I was not required to as the cab is equipped to take cards. He became angry screaming that he "likes money!" He was loud and acting very erratically. I begged him to let me scan my card on the Verifone because he was harassing me and essentially keeping me hostage in his cab. He would not allow me to do that. He

again screamed that he "liked money". I said let me scan my card and let me out of this cab. I told him I was going to call his company. He finally relented. The charge went through fine.

He printed the receipt and said "look, look, I don't get this money, I like money, GIVE ME MY MONEY!" I exited the cab and he was screaming at me "give me my money". People were staring at me as though I hadn't paid my fare. I ran inside Walgreens hoping that he did not follow me in.

I was terrified because he was screaming at me and turning around trying to get in my face from the front seat. It was humiliating and harassment. I was just a woman who wanted to get home after a day of work. I did not deserve that treatment simply because he wanted payment HIS way. He is a danger to the city and I'm almost positive he has displayed this anger before with others. His license needs to be revoked.

I have worked at US Bank at the downtown Milwaukee US Bank building for over nine years. I regularly ride the Amtrak train from Glenview, Illinois to downtown Milwaukee as part of my routine commute. I then routinely take a cab from the Amtrak station in Milwaukee to the US Bank Building (777 East Wisconsin Ave) as part of my daily commute. I realize it is a "short ride" for the drivers that wait at the Amtrak station in the mornings at 7:30 AM for the Amtrak passengers needing a cab. This is why I always pay \$10 for the fare as this is well above the \$5 or so fare amount - but I appreciate their time in waiting at the cab stand for a short fare.

I had an issue this morning with the driver in American United Taxi cab #89 at 7:30 AM at the Amtrak station. When I approached his cab, his car doors were locked and he would not open his doors. I explained to WALY that the money was still not adding up correctly. WALY apoligized and offered to return money if necessary. I asked WALY if he had his trip records from the date. WALY provided me with his trip records dated from April 21. I asked why he had not filled out his daily trip records in the past week. WALY did not have any reasonable answer. WALY stated he rents the cab from the premit holder. The permit holder was Lisa SHIKHMAN, W/F, 04-23-59, of 6508 W. Aspen Tree Ct., Mequon, WI. WALY was issued a citation for Public passenger vehicle - daily trip record required.

To Whom It May Concern:

This is a complaint against MKE Cab license # 140.

My husband and I rode from the MKE airport to our home at I can't say specifically what time we got into the cab, but we were driven directly home, and I had to call 911 at 9:25pm, so I would say we started the ride at approx 9:00pm.

As we entered the cab my husband specifically asked the driver, "you take credit cards, right?", and the driver replied, "oh, yes, yes!". All is well and good until we arrived at our destination. We handed the driver our card as there was NO terminal installed in the cab. He took our card, then reached over to the passenger side of the cab and exclaimed, "OH NO! I left my phone at home, it has the thing, I don't have a way of taking the credit card!". (what cab driver leaves his phone at home!?!)

We reminded the driver that we specifically asked, about accepting credit card payment, and he specifically said he did. Then he said, "wait, wait, I'll see if I can do it another way". Then proceeded to fumble around with a huge pile of papers on the passenger side floor, as if looking for a paper/swipe set-up. Naturally he was not able to produce that either. I said, "why don't you call your dispatcher and I can give them the card # and they can process it over the phone". That's when he said, "what dispatcher, it's just me." I went to grab the credit card back from him and he refused to let go, yelling "hey, hey, hey!!!". I told him if he didn't give us the card back that I would

call the police. He said, "fine - call them, go ahead, call them". That's when I dialed 911. In the mean time, my husband offered him \$20 to let us out of the cab and give us our bag back. He refused saying he can write down the card number and run the card "later".

I got a 911 operator on the line and described our problem with the cab driver to her as quickly as possible - she could barely hear me (and visa versa) as the driver was screaming so loudly at that point. I was actually beginning to fear for our safety. I told her that we had agreed on a credit card transaction and that basically we were now being held against our will, by a cab driver that was holding our credit card against our will! I think once the cabbie realized that I actually was on the phone with the police, he agreed to take the \$20 and get rid of us, so he could get out of there before the police actually arrived.

The only identification in the entire cab that I could find was the cab # 140 (a silver mini-van with red lettering). I never asked him his name, nor would he have given it to me I'm certain. I could identify him in a photo though. Their certainly was no "Non-cash Payment Passenger Usage Guide" posted anywhere in the cab or I wouldn't have needed to hunt and peck online to fine it buried here on the City of Milwaukee website!

I've never even come close to filing a complaint like this before, but I've heard cabbie horror stories from others (especially women traveling alone). Enough is enough. What if we had been out of town visitors? What sort of impression would that have been? I'm embarrassed just thinking about it.

Please follow-up with me so that I know this complaint has been heard, and what, if anything will be done in handling it.
