There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/01/24 at 11:58p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 134 E. Juneau Ave, due to excessive music coming from outdoor speakers. The officer advised the manager of the ordinance requirements relating to outdoor music. Initially the manager was upset, however, calmed down and stated they understood why it was important to get the music under control. The manager was further advised regarding the main door being locked during business hours.

The following items are related to 134 E. Juneau Ave., Mojo MKE.

2. On 01/01/25, at 1:50 a.m., officers assigned to Code Red responded to a Fight. Two female subjects engaged in a physical fight which resulted in a large crowd physically fighting inside of the business. Security camera footage was available for officers to review.
3. On 04/04/25, at 1:14 a.m., officers assigned to Code Red were flagged down for a Trouble with Subject. Three subjects caused a disturbance at a neighboring business after being refused entry due to fake ID's. The subjects were stopped, found to be in possession of fake ID's, and under the influence of intoxicants which were consumed earlier at Mojo. A manager admitted the three subjects were in the business. All three had ID's that were

scanned. Security camera footage was allowed to be reviewed, showing the subjects in the business. All three subjects were cited. The business was cited, but all charges were dismissed in Milwaukee Municipal Court.

4. On 04/19/25, at 12:15 a.m., Officers assigned to Code Red responded to a Fight in front of the business. Officers observed a group of approximately 15-20 people engaged in physical fight in front of the business and attempted to break it up. Additional officers were called to assist with the crowd. While attempting to deal with the fight a second group of subjects engaged in a physical fight outside of the same location.
5. On 05/15/25, at 1:39 a.m., officers assigned to Code Red observed a Fight between multiple subjects inside of the business. Officers attempted to intervene, but found the door was locked causing them to wait until an employee unlocked the door. Employees assisted officers in controlling the crowd. Two subjects were arrested, one subject was found to be under 21 years old and under the influence of an intoxicant. Both subjects were cited. The business was cited, but all charges were dismissed in Milwaukee Municipal Court.

This report is being written by P.O. David GONZALEZ, assigned to District 1, Late Power Shift, Squad 1421.

On Wednesday, January 1st, 2025, I, P.O. GONZALEZ, along with my partner, P.O. Jason CHADWICK, were on a special assignment on N Water St and E Juneau Ave, in the City and County of Milwaukee.

At approximately 1:50 AM, I, P.O. GONZALEZ, observed a male who identified as Rolando A. GALARZA (H/M 03/24/2000) getting kicked out of Mojors MKE, which is located on 134 E JUNEAU AVE. There was an altercation in front of Mojors MKE that caused police to get involved. I, P.O. GONZALEZ then spoke to GALARZA who stated that he was getting jumped by the security inside of Mojors MKE. GALARZA stated that he was with his sister and friends when he observed his sister get into an argument with a female subject that they did not know. GALARZA stated that his sister and the female subject started to throw punches. GALARZA stated that everything happened so fast, so he did not get to see why there was a fight, but he then tried to stop his sister. GALARZA stated that in the process of calming his sister down, random people in the crowd got involved, including the security at the listed address above. GALARZA stated that he was getting punched in the back of the head and kicked by security but does not recall if there were other people involved.

Follow-up was made at the listed address above to check for video. I, P.O. GONZALEZ spoke to the general manager of Mojors MKE who verbally identified himself as Jordan D. WILLIAMS (W/M 07/18/1991) who showed us video of the time of the incident. In the video, I observed two female subjects get into a physical fight and GALARZA trying to intervene. I observed the crowd surrounding the three became a part of the fight as there was pushing and shoving. I observed security grab GALARZA from behind and tried to pull him away from the fight, and in the process, GALARZA was trying to break away from the security. I observed that the security were trying to stop the fight, but both the security and GALARZA were getting punched from the out of control crowd, and were throwing punches back. Due to the out of control crowd, security were escorting GALARZA and his sister out of the listed address above.

WILLIAMS also showed us the id scanner and all three subjects were scanned in and the fake id's they used were registered as good. P.O. SILKEY informed WILLIAMS that they will be receiving citations, since all three subjects were under age and we were able to establish they were in their bar consuming alcohol.

On April 6th, 2025 at approximately 9:00 P.M., P.O. SILKEY and I met with WILLIAMS to deliver the citations. Three citations were issued. WILLIAMS stated that he would deliver the citations to the owner.

This report is written by P.O. Nathaniel PETERSEN, assigned to District #1, Late Power Shift, Squad 1420, with P.O. Michael MICHALAK.

On Saturday, April 19th, 2025, P.O. Michael MICHALAK and I (Squad 1420), while equipped with Axon body worn camera, wearing full duty Milwaukee Police uniform, and operating a full Milwaukee Police vehicle (#65109), were assigned to work code red deployment at 125 E. Juneau Ave. (Trinity Bar) / N. Water St. / E. Juneau Ave., in the City and County of Milwaukee.

On Saturday, April 19th, 2025, at approximately 12:15 A.M. I observed a large group of individuals fighting in front of the location 134 E. Juneau Ave. (Mojos MKE) who were punching and grabbing on to each other. Multiple officers responded to the incident to break up the physical altercation which was estimated to be 15-20 people. Officers on scene attempted to split up the altercation of one group who was fighting. An additional group was also observed who was engaged in a physical altercation at the same location which officers attempted to split up as well. Due to the large crowd of people fighting and ignoring officer's commands on scene, I attempted to use my OC spray on the crowd to separate everyone from fighting. A female subject was taken into custody as a result of this altercation who was later identified as Shatara C. MOBLEY (B/F, 4-19-1995). MOBLEY was later transported to District #1, where she received a citation (J981NNZLXT) with a future court date with an explanation of today's event and citation procedure. MOBLEY actions were performed in a public/private place, which provoked a disturbance.

No employees at this location performed any actions that would have obstructed this investigation.

This report is written by PO Benjamin Delaney, District 1 assigned to Late Power shift as Squad 1430 with PO Shawn Switzer.

On Thursday May 15th 2025 at approximately 1:39 a.m. Squad 1430, Squad 1460 (PO Justin Silkey and PO Richard Michalak), Squad 1441 (PO Kara Placzek and PO Jazarreya Smith), Squad 1431 (PO Chad Wilson and PO Joel Bandkowski), Squad 1490 (PO Andrew Dudley) and Squad 1412 (Sgt Ryan McElroy) were in the area of N Edison St and E Juneau Av for a special assignment to monitor the bars in the area.

While monitoring 134 E Juneau Av, Mojo MKE, from the outside, officers observed a fight break out between multiple subjects inside the bar. When officers tried to get into the bar to break up the fight, the front door was locked and officers had to wait for staff to unlock the door, preventing us from intervening earlier. When the doors finally were opened all above listed officers were needed to break up the fight and separate the involved parties.

As the incident settled down the staff was cooperative and assisted in getting the involved parties out of the area. From this incident there were two arrests made, one of which was a subject who was under the age of 21. After being conveyed to District 1 and performing a PBT test, her breath tested positive for alcohol. This subject received two citations. First citation number 0681JXM81P for Disorderly Conduct. Second citation number 0681KX84GG, for Underage Drinking.

The other subject arrested in this incident was issued one citation, citation number J981NNZLZH, for Disorderly Conduct.

Mojo MKE was issued four citations. First citation number M582HQT5JX, for Allow Consumption of Alcohol by an Underage person 2nd within 12 months. Second citation number M582HQT5K0, for Allow Underage Person on the Premise. Third citation number M582HQT5K1, Sale of Alcohol to Underage

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
