AMENDMENT TO COLLECTION SERVICES FOR RECEIVABLES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE

<u>RECITALS</u>
A. The City and the Kohn Law Firm entered into a January 1, 1997 Collection Services
for Receivables of City of Milwaukee contract (the "Contract").
B. The City now desires to expand the scope of services of the Contract to include the
collection of delinquent City real property taxes, special charges, special assessments, and
special taxes (individually and collectively herein called "Real Property Taxes") which the City
Attorney has determined should be collected through an <u>in personam</u> action against the property
owner (or, as the case may be, the former owner) as provided in sec. 304-48-4, Milwaukee Code
of Ordinances.
C. The City's Common Council has authorized the execution of this Amendment via
Common Council File No adopted
Now, Therefore, In consideration of the recitals and for the other good and valuable

A. Article III.B. of the Contract is amended to include a new Article III.B.7. which provides:

consideration hereinafter set forth, the parties agree as follows:

"7. Collection of delinquent City Real Property Taxes from owners (or, as the case may be, former owners) whom the City Attorney has determined should be

subject to <u>in personam</u> actions in accordance with sec. 304-48-4, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances."

B. The Kohn Law Firm shall be compensated for its services under Article III.B.7. in accordance with the provisions of Article VII.A.2.a and b. C. Kohn Law Firm may not compromise claims for Real Property Taxes. D. Kohn Law Firm shall collect interest and penalties on Real Property Taxes in accordance with the statutory formula. E.
