I received your appeal for the reinspection fees charged against the above property for tax year 2002. The appeal was faxed to me from the Treasurer's office on 8/4/03. A check of our records shows the following information.

The charges are a result of three orders issued to you in late 2000. Order #s 3088932, 3091321 and 3097201 were for exterior violations: porch repairs, chimney repairs, exterior painting and roof eave. Monthly exterior reinspections on this property began in November of 2001. The property was boarded in September of 2001.

There was a total of \$2,075 placed on the 2002 tax bill. Chargeable reinspections were conducted at the property on 1/22/01, 2/7/01, 3/7/01, 11/2/01, 12/20/01, 1/16/02, 2/11/02, 3/7/02, and 7/11/02. The district inspector reinspected the property on 8/22/03, found compliance and abated the orders.

You had been previously litigated in Municipal Court in fall of 2000 for orders on this property. You were fined for not complying. Per department policy the property was resurveyed, orders were issued and after the compliance time on the new orders had expired, the property was put on monthly reinspections.

I am denying your appeal at the department level. Should you wish to appeal this decision, please complete the enclosed application for the Administrative Review Appeals Board and submit as directed. This appeal must be submitted and accepted by the Administrative Review Appeals Board within 30 days of this letter.
