
Dear Alderman Pratt:

As part of our on-going effort to verify field parking sign installations with ordinance records on file in the Legislative Reference Bureau, we have discovered that the signs for the parking restrictions listed below are not present in the field. The area residents or businesses have not questioned the absence of these signs, and we believe that the restrictions are no longer needed. We, therefore, recommend that the ordinances be repealed. The changes we propose will only correct City ordinances and will not affect field signing, nor have any effect on your constituents.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting to remove the following restrictions:

1. North Teutonia Avenue in front of 4552 - No Parking
2. North 19th Street from West Olive Street to West Fiebrantz Avenue -- Two Hour Parking
3. North 27th Street from West Atkinson Avenue to West Port Sunlight Way -- Two Hour Parking






