Dear Friends:


Currently, we at Love Tabernacle Church urge the Department of Natural Resources and the Historic Preservation Office to grant us the mothball we so desperately need. We are currently working with Community Roofing (a roof restoration contractor) to get the first phase of the project completed. As a non-profit organization most of our funding is generated through various fundraising efforts and from the contributions of other churches and individuals. For this reason, we have encountered somewhat of a challenge in acquiring the capital we need to complete the project in the timeline as we had initially planned. However, our contractor has been working diligently with us and has agreed to offer us an affordable payment plan and will start our project by mid-June, 2013.

In the interim, our friends at Community Roofing have already made minor improvements to the roof by water proofing it. They have assured us that the waterproofing repairs will hold until the permanent work begins in June. With that being said, Love Tabernacle is asking for the Department of Neighborhood Services to grant us the opportunity to occupy the first floor of our building so we can open our doors and resume the opportunity to serve the people of the community in which we have come to know and love for more than 40 years.

Please note that if given the opportunity to occupy the building while the construction is underway, we plan to deny any (and all) access to all unqualified persons on the other levels by framing out the staircase and securing it, and disconnecting the electricity source to all other levels. Additionally, we will continuously communicate our progress to DNS as we work towards our goal.
