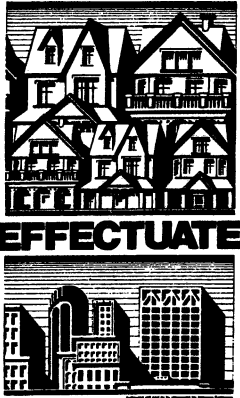

I have been advised that BOZA would like to consider certain additional prohibitions in the Plans of Operation they approve, where necessary, for gas stations and/or convenience and grocery stores. There is a belief these further requirements to be added to the Plans of Operation must be added to our ordinances for BOZA to add them.

I would like to add the following to whichever of our ordinances will achieve the goals.

1. All litter must be cleaned up by licensee within 1/2 block radius of their location, including across streets and alleys.
2. Prohibit the sale of glass tubes marketed as flower holders by classifying them as drug paraphernalia; prohibit sale of cigars of any thickness which are unpackaged (singles) or in any smaller package than a 4 pack; prohibit sale of "chore boys" or steel wool not containing soap by classifying them as drug paraphernalia.

Please talk to City Attorney and/or staff of BOZA regarding your drafting so we include all necessary (even several separate resolutions and/or ordinances) to achieve the goals of reducing litter and access to commonly used illegal drug use accoutrements.
