WHEREAS, *Pride Month honorees are exemplary figures in the Milwaukee community who demonstrate outstanding contributions in civic, professional, and humanitarian pursuits; and*

WHEREAS, *Dan Terrio currently serves as the Diversity and Inclusion Manager for Milwaukee County utilizing a Restorative Justice approach to diversity, equity and inclusion efforts, for Wisconsin's largest County and its 4,000 employees, and he aims to bring an Indigenous and LGBTQ+ perspective in his work and key teachings from his tribal community; and*
