This report is written by Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Day Shift. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/13/2024 at 6:29 PM., officers responded to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Battery Complaint follow-up. Security footage showed, on 04/13/24, at 12:26 AM., an employee was attempting to physically escort a male out of the store. The male strikes the employee twice to the head and both subjects exchange punches. As both subjects are engaged in a physical altercation, a second employee strikes the male on the back with a wooden stick. The first employee pushes the male out to the parking lot where he sat for short time before panhandling in parking lot. An officer called and spoke to the owner who did not have any information regarding the employees, but stated he would get it to them and both employees involved were fired.
2. On 04/13/2024 at 3:09 PM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Robbery Complaint. The suspect a known shoplifter entered the business, took four cases of soda without paying, and exited the store into the alley. The suspect returned to the store and entered the rear storage room. An employee went into the storage room and observed the suspect with two cases of Red Bull. The employee told the suspect to stop, before getting pushed to the ground as the suspect fled. The employee sustained minor abrasion to their arm due to the fall. The items were valued at \$227.96. Video was available of the incident and no license violations observed.
3. On 04/25/2024 at 10:30 AM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Theft Complaint. An employee called regarding a known wanted suspect involved in the incident which occurred on 04/13/24. That suspect was taken into custody without incident. No license violations observed.
4. On 05/03/2024 at 10:23 PM, officers were dispatched to 2627 W Capitol Dr for a Shotspotter Complaint. While investigating officers were made aware that a victim had arrived at the hospital

with injuries sustained while shots were fired at the gas station. Officers were able to recover the surveillance footage that confirmed the driver of the suspect vehicle exited and shot at another vehicle that was parked at the gas station before fleeing. The business was cooperative with the investigation.

5. On 05/15/2024 at 6:15 PM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. An employee called for police service and locked the door to prevent a known suspect from leaving with items they were attempting to steal. The suspect realized they could not leave and started damaging property. Officers placed the suspect into custody without incident. No license violations observed.
6. On 05/18/2024 at 12:28 AM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Theft complaint. Four Juvenile suspects entered the store and started removing several items off the shelves. The employee attempted to exit from behind the counter to confront the suspects. One suspect grabbed for a gun that was in their pocket, and threatened to shoot the employee if he came out. The suspects fled with items valued around \$70 -\$80.00. Video was available of the incident and no license violations observed.
7. On 05/23/2024 at 7:46 PM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. Three juvenile suspects entered the store and one concealed items in their pocket. The employee attempted to confront the suspect and a second suspect made threats to shoot the employee if they exit from behind the counter as a gun was displayed. The suspects grabbed additional items and flee the store. Video was available of the incident and no license violations observed.
8. On 06/22/2024 at 11:00 PM., on 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, a theft occurred at 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas. The victim was walking into the business with their phone in hand as the suspect walked past, grabbed the victim's phone and fled. This incident was reported at the district on 06/25/24 by the victim.
9. On 07/09/2024 at 4:40 PM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Property Damage complaint. A subject entered the business, became upset and knocked over a rack of merchandise. Video was available of the incident and no license violations observed.
10. On 10/15/2024 at 1:00 PM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Theft complaint. A known subject entered the business and took items without making payment. Officers cited the subject. Video was available of the incident and no license violations observed.
11. On 10/17/24, at 8:41p.m., officers were dispatched to a Subject with weapon complaint. A neighbor reported a vehicle parked in the lot with the occupants selling narcotics, and one subject possessing a firearm. The investigation revealed the occupants were in possession of a substance which tested positive for 7.26 grams of THC. Both subjects were arrested.
12. On 01/04/2025 at 10:47 AM., officers were dispatched to 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas, for a Violation of Restraining Order complaint. A known suspect entered the business in violation of a court ordered, which was properly served. The suspect placed an item in the door preventing the magnetic locking system from being activated, and fled with items valued at \$53 dollars.

13. On 01/06/2025 at 1:03 AM., An officer conducted a License Premise check at 2627 W. Capitol Dr., Clark Gas. All licenses were posted and valid. Cameras were working and available for viewing at any time. The officer did find chips, candy and other items offered for sale past the expiration date. The employee removed most of the items and held some to be credited by the vendors.

The following items are related to 2627 W. Capitol Dr.

14. On 01/13/25, at 8:26 a.m., Milwaukee Police received a Violation of Restraining Order complaint. An employee called regarding a known suspect in the business violating an active court order. The suspect was gone prior to officers' arrival.
15. On 01/31/25, at 11:46 a.m., officers were dispatched to a Subject with Gun complaint. An employee reported a suspect pulled a gun on them after becoming upset because they didn't have enough money. The suspect fled prior to officers' arrival.
16. On 02/03/25, at 4:18 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Property Damage complaint. An unknown subject entered the business yelling and throwing merchandise around. The subject left prior to officers' arrival.

While the actor is standing there, three employees approached them with large sticks. The actor is struck multiple times with sticks, closed fist, and kicked while lying on the ground. As the actor attempted to leave employees pulled them back in. The door was locked by an employee and then the actor is tied and restrained with large garbage bags. While the actor was on the ground employees kicked them multiple more times. The robbery was found to be baseless. All three employees were arrested.
18. On 04/04/25, at 8:37 p.m., an officer was dispatched to a Battery complaint. The caller stated they were pushed and spat on at the business. The suspect was found to be an employee. Security camera footage showed a verbal altercation between the two, but no physical altercation besides the employee pushing the caller out of the business.
19. On 04/05/25, at 10:39 p.m., officers were dispatched to a Shot Spotter call for service. Employees allowed officers to review security camera footage. A check of the business revealed some expired merchandise. The employee was advised to check merchandise and discard any expired food items.

The first suspect yelled at employees causing fear and knocked down a rack of chips. The second suspect grabbed bags of chips off the floor and both fled prior to officers' arrival.

Officers before arrival were notified that the subject was still on scene and locked inside by the store employees and wasn't sure if they had a weapon. Upon officer's arrivals, I observed a Black female down on the ground tied up with black plastic bags crying with staff employees standing around her.

I spoke to one of the employees, later identified verbally as Zuheib SYED (W/M 11/20/2005) who stated that woman, later identified as Timica EUBANKS (B/F 03/09/1977) is a regular at this location and that her and her boyfriend always come inside this place of business and steal from them. SYED stated that they have video of EUBANKS coming into the store stealing/ or damaging property. SYED stated that she came into the location on today's date, 02/20/2025 at approximately 04:17 AM and that they have a restraining order against EUBANKS.

Video footage was captured of the incident that took place at this location, and officers reviewed the video. I reviewed the video surveillance on today's date, 02/20/2025 and I didn't see any robbery. I spoke with the owner and provided a link to Evidence.com so that this surveillance footage could be uploaded and put on Milwaukee Police Department inventory. SYED stated there was 16 cameras located on the exterior of this location, and all were operational, and 6 inside this location that were operational. As I began watching the footage of the incident, I observed EUBANKS enter the gas station (the dispatched location of 2627 W Capitol Drive) at 04:17AM. I observed EUBANKS standing at the front entrance door, facing SOUTH, with her back facing the glass where the employees were standing behind. I then observed employees: ARETI, KATHPAL and SYED approach EUBANKS and intentionally and without consent strike her multiple times with their fists. ARETI, SYED AND KATHPAL all ran towards EUBANKS with wooden sticks, approximately 5 feet long, and struck her multiple times throughout the altercation with the sticks. EUBANKS attempted to leave the store when she was pulled back into the store and KATHPAL locked the door to keep EUBANKS from leaving the location. EUBANKS was then tied and restrained with large black garbage bags and was kicked multiple times, as well. The altercation ended at approximately 04:30AM when Police arrived.

All employees on scene were arrested.

This report is written by Police Officer Shelisa CARSON, assigned to District 5, Early Shift, Squad 5221.

On Thursday September 25, 2025, my partner PO Evan BILLER and I were dispatched to a Theft complaint at 2627 W. Capitol Dr. located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon our arrival, I observed patrons going in and out of the establishment. I did not see anyone causing a disturbance inside or outside.

I spoke to the caller, identified as Areti SURYEA (A/M, 08/02/1995, ph# 414-497-6009). SURYEA stated there was a group of young adult males, who entered the store and remained in the store causing a disturbance for approximately an hour and a half. SURYEA stated he asked the males to leave, in which they refused and remained in the store. SURYEA stated the males had began taking small items, opening them and consuming them without paying. SURYEA stated he was not too concerned with the theft portion, just the fact that they were disturbance the other customers. SURYEA stated they males finally left the location and one male began throwing items in the store as he was exiting. SURYEA stated he called the police shortly before they exited the store.

I spoke to licensed premise employee who was also the caller. The business was cooperative with the investigation. The business had 0 security officers on scene.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. The footage showed approximately 4 males loitering in the store for an unknown amount of time. I observed a B/M, dark skin, orange shirt, navy blue jacket, black pants, light colored shoes, and a black mask on his head, approx. 18-21 years old. The described male was seen on camera taking a soda and drinking it as well as opening and eating a bag of candy. The male was then seen handing the other male subjects items and putting it in a lime green bookbag. The male was seen throwing items in the store and at the worker, as he was exiting the store. The male/ group was seen walking eastbound on W. Capitol Dr. from the location.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date.
